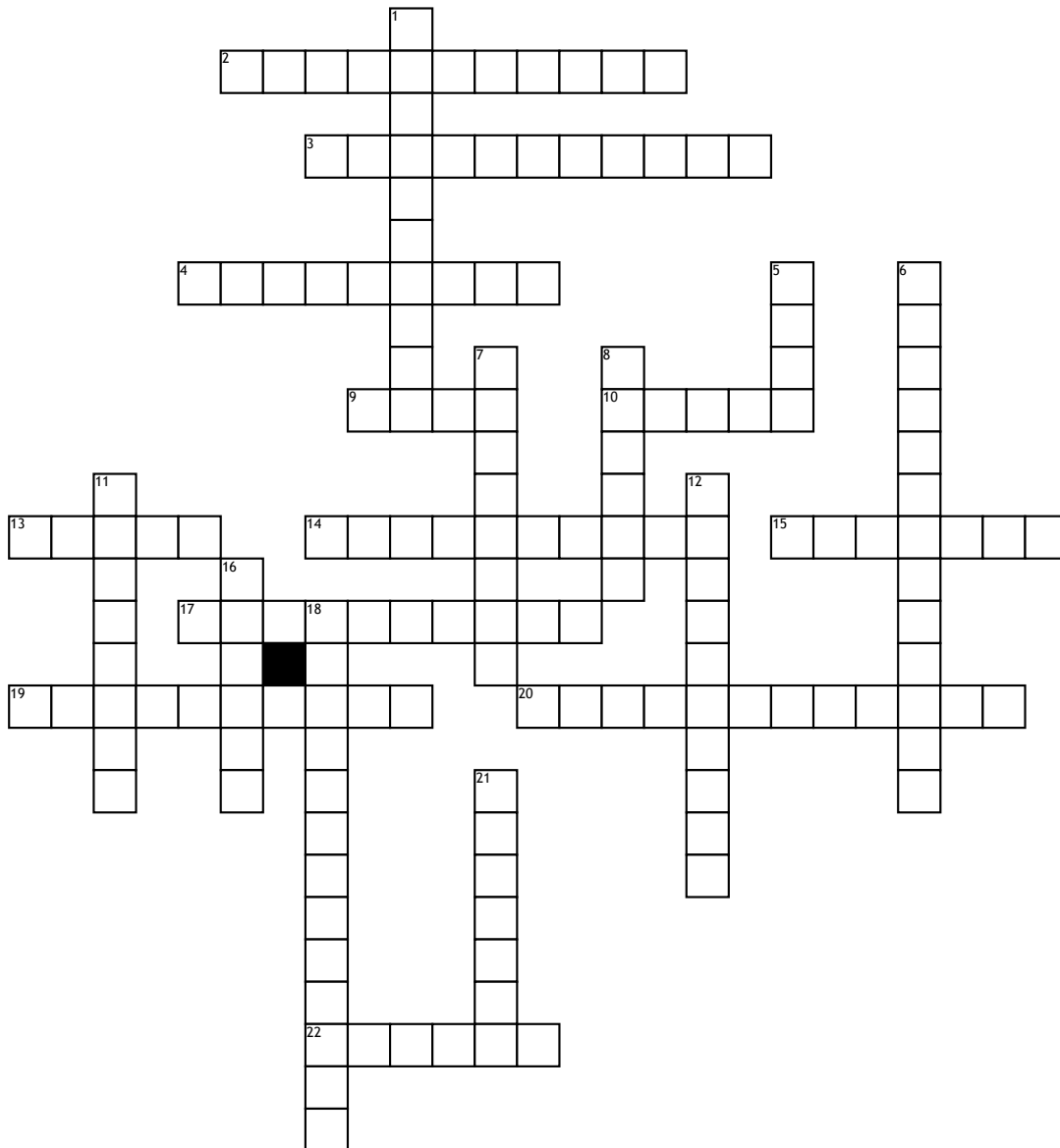


ENGLISH12 CROSSWORD PUZZLE
