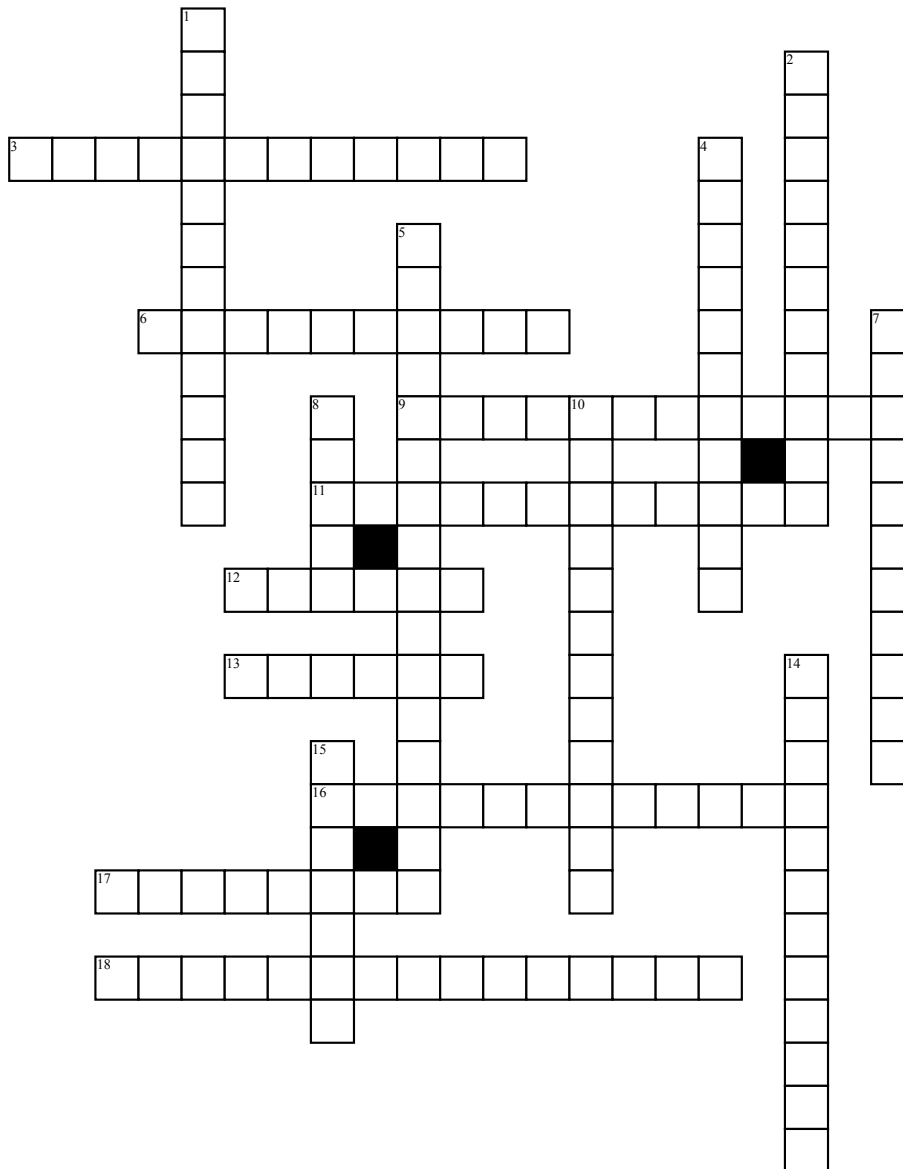


# EYE and OCULAR ADNEXA



## Across

- 3.** Orbit, extraocular muscles and eyelid  
**6.** Extraocular muscle deviation resulting in unequal visual axes  
**9.** Removal of the eye, adnexa and part of the bony orbit  
**11.** Removal of the contents of the globe while leaving the extraocular muscles and sclera intact  
**12.** White outer portion of the eyeball

- 13.** Transparent part of the eye

- 16.** Presence of artificial lens  
**17.** Opaque covering on or in the lens  
**18.** Part of the eye in the front of and including the lens, orbit, extraocular muscles and eyelid

## Down

- 1.** Removal of fluid  
**2.** removal of the eye while leaving the orbital structures intact

- 4.** Condition in which the refractive surfaces of the eyes are unequal

- 5.** Parts of the eye located behind the lens  
**7.** Lining of the eyelids and covering of the sclera  
**8.** Vascular tissue of the choroids, ciliary body and iris  
**10.** Suturing together of the eyelids  
**14.** Repair of the cornea  
**15.** Absence of the lens of the eye
