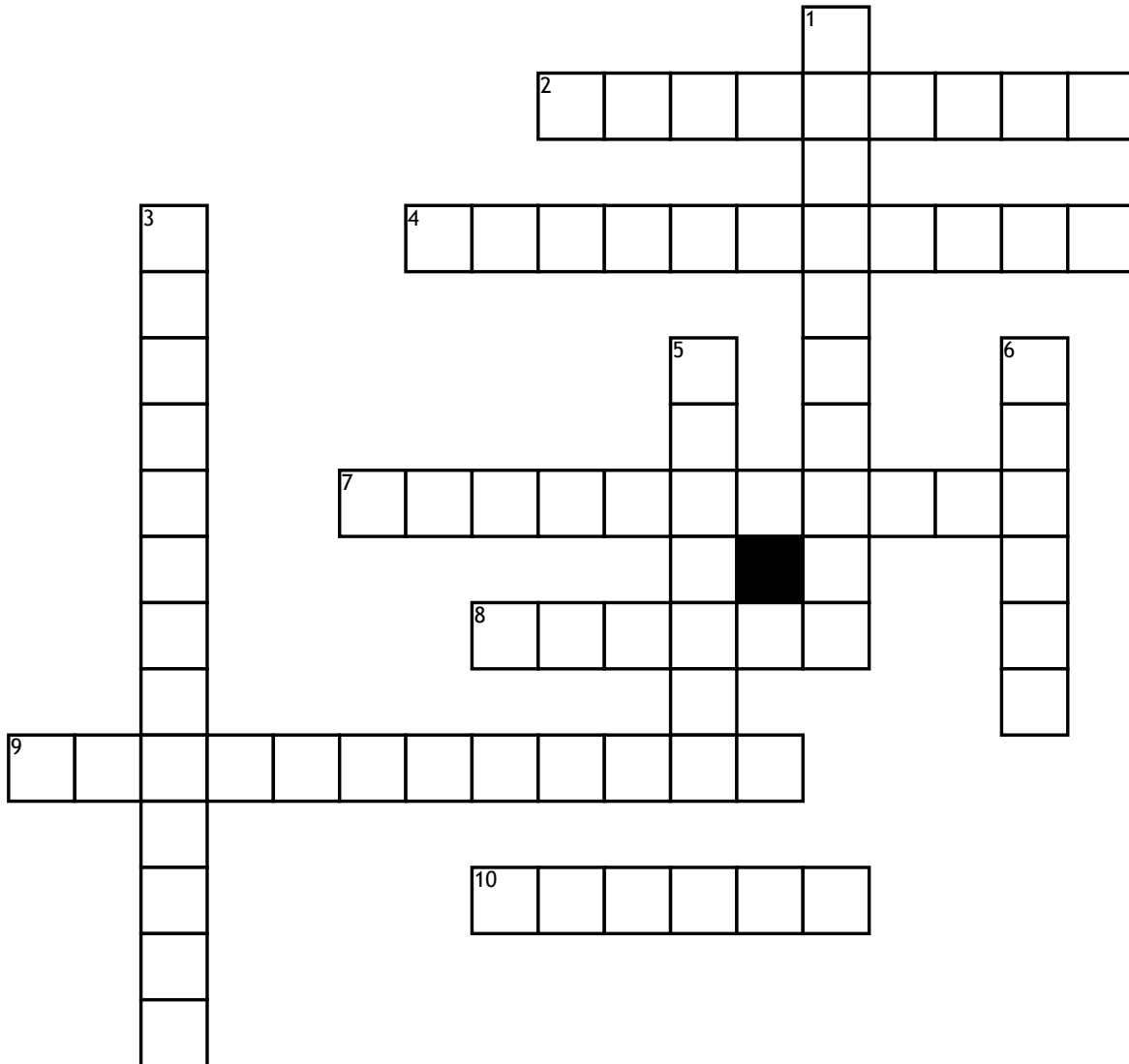


Early Civilizations of China
