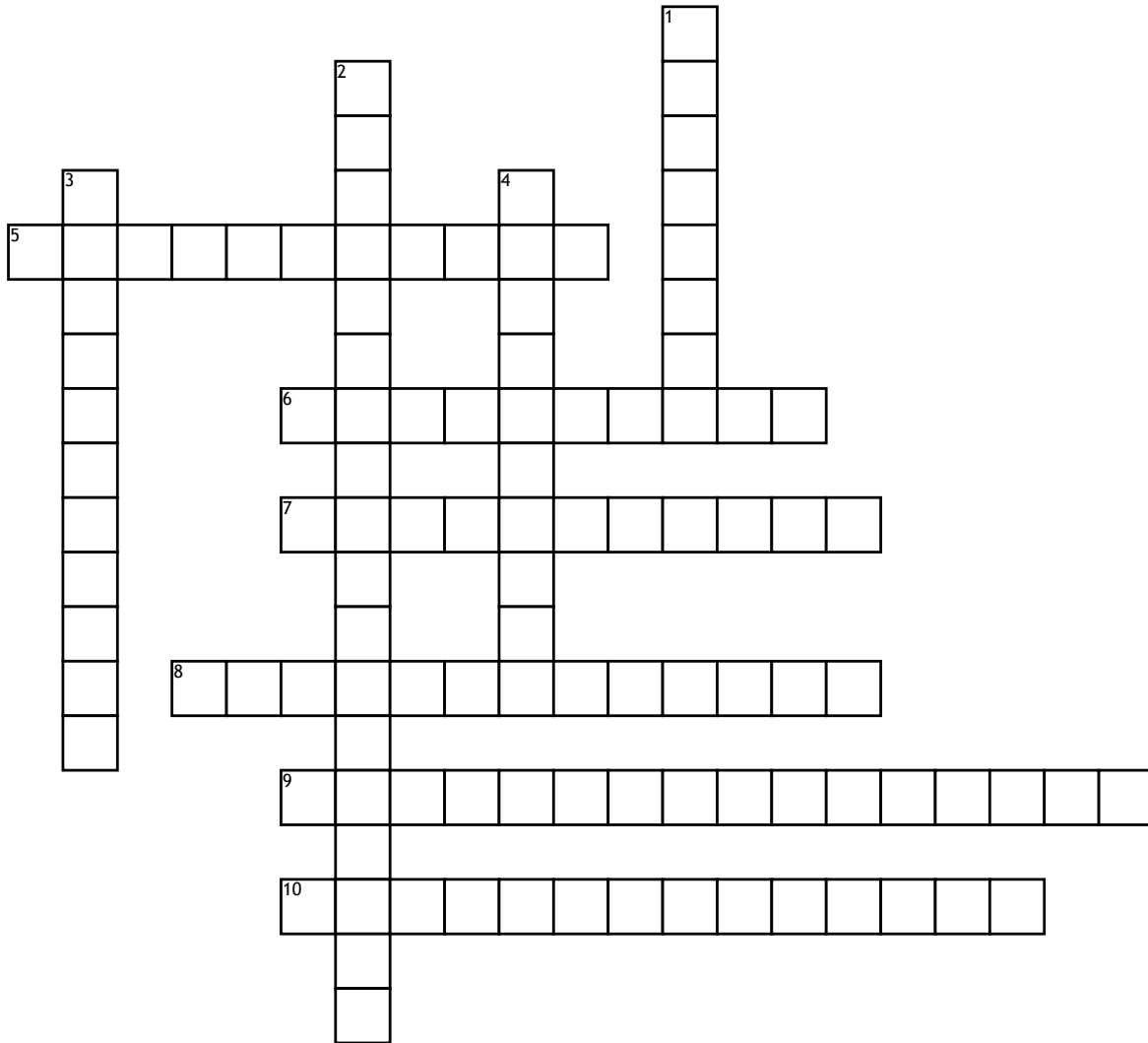

- 5. Cues created by movements of objects or movements of the body; provide information for the perception of forms and spatial
- 6. Fusion of two images to produce a single image that has depth
- 7. Decrease in response to a stimulus that has become familiar through repetition
- 8. Tendency to perceive an object as the same size from different distances despite changes in the size of its retinal image
- 9. An increase in responsiveness that occurs when stimulation changes

- 10. Amount of light/dark transition in a visual stimulus

Down

- 1. Smallest meaningful sound units that make up a spoken language
- 2. Changes in ability to extract information from sensory stimulation that occurs as a result of experience
- 3. Elevated platform that creates an illusion of depth; used to test the depth perception of infants
- 4. A process by which we categorize and interpret sensory input
