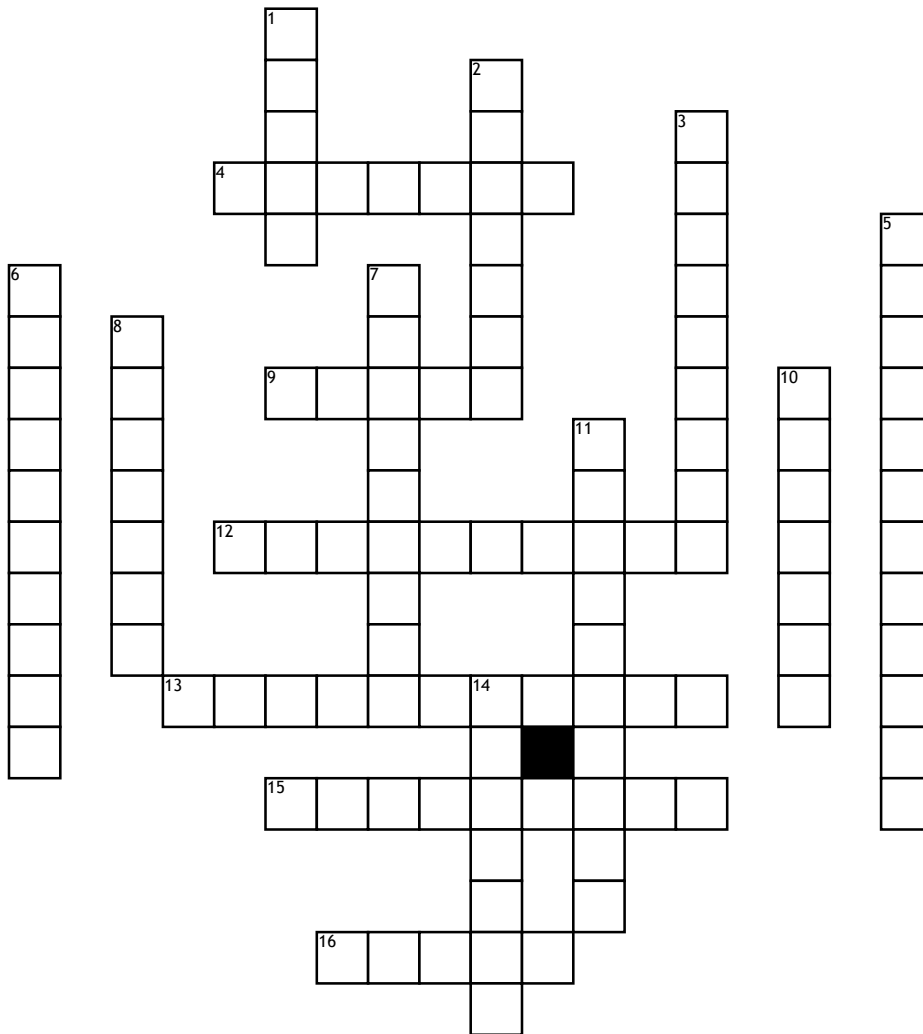


# Early North American Civilizations
