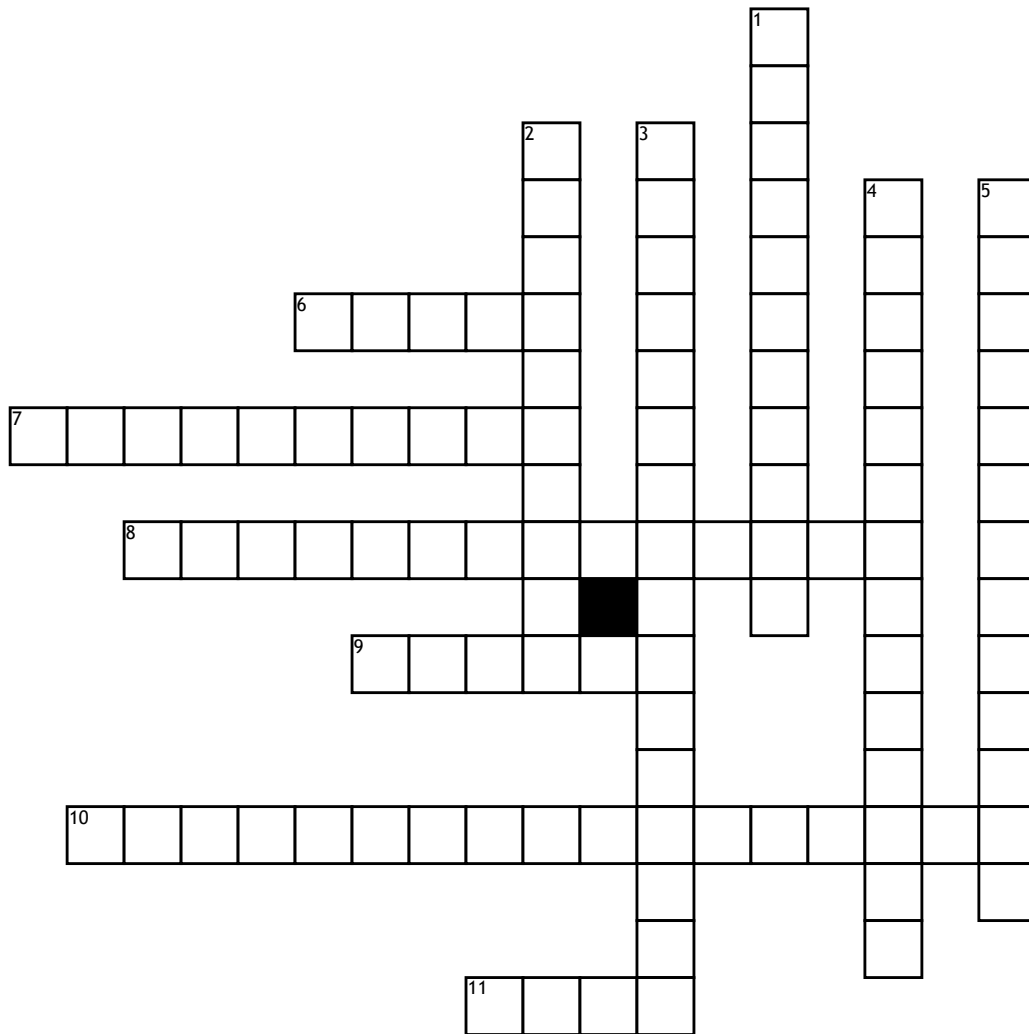

- 1. The action or state of being squished down or made smaller or more pressed together.
- 2. Wear away or change the appearance or texture of something by long exposure to the air.
- 3. The gradual movement of the continents across the earth's surface through geological time.
- 4. A tectonic boundary where two plates are moving away from each other and new crust is forming from magma that rises to the Earth's surface between the two plates.
- 5. An underwater mountain system formed by plate tectonics.
