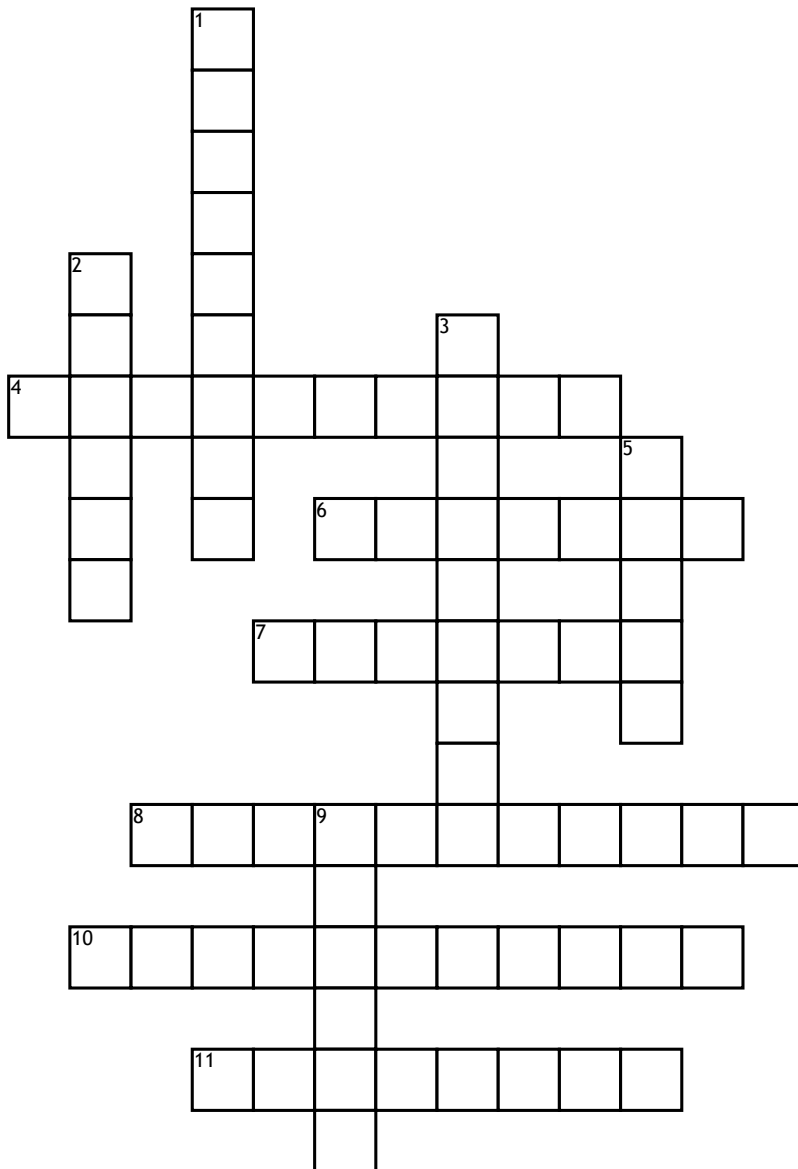


Earthquake Crossword

- 4. The shaking and trembling that results from movement of rock beneath Earth's surface.
- 6. The stress force that pulls on the crust and thins rock in the middle.
- 7. A large area of flat land elevated high above sea level.
- 8. The stress force that squeezes rock until it folds or breaks.
- 10. The fault that cuts through rock at an angle, so one block of rock sits over the fault, while the other block lies under the fault.

- 11. Stress that pushes a mass of rock in two opposite directions.

- 1. The point on the surface directly above the focus
- 2. Seismic waves that can vibrate from side to side.
- 3. A single number that geologists assign to an earthquake based on the earthquake's size.
- 5. The area beneath Earth's surface where rock that was under stress begins to break or move
