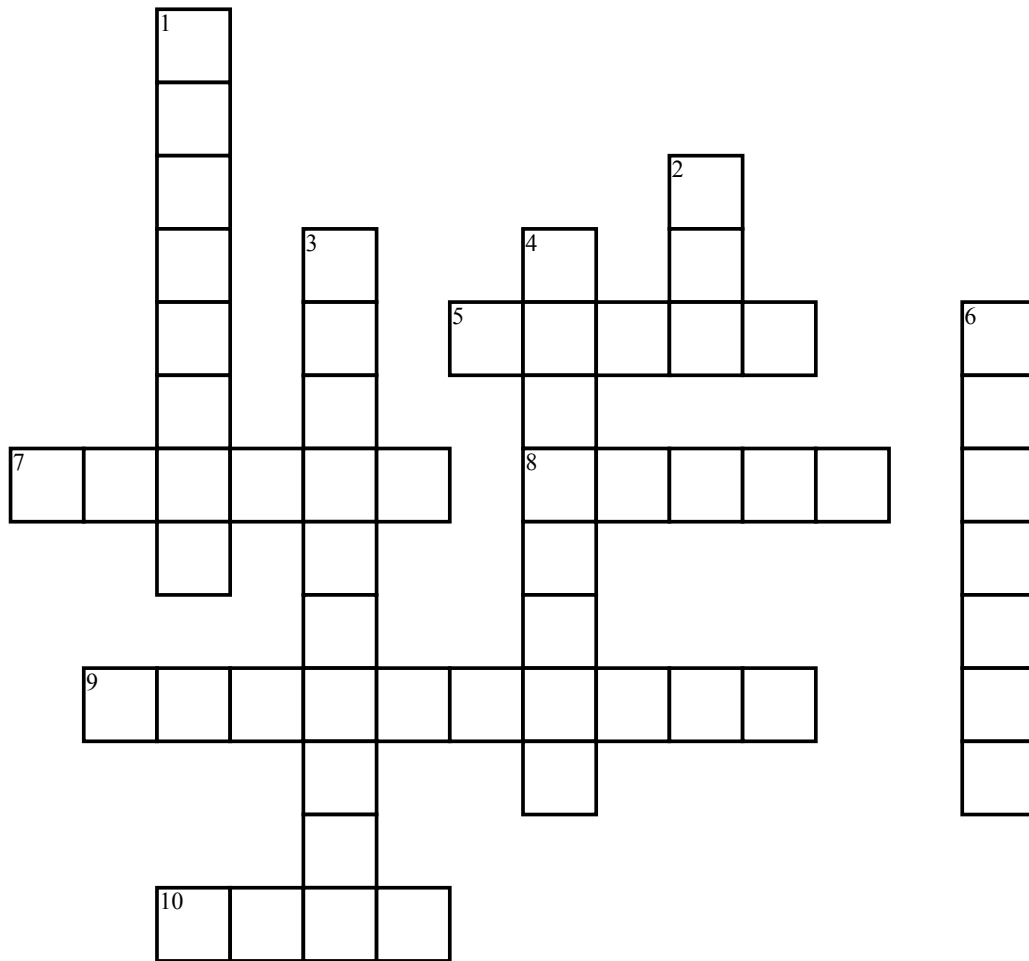


Earth's Landforms

5. A colorless, transparent, odorless liquid that forms the seas, lakes, rivers, and rain.
 7. A deep narrow valley with steep sides, sometimes with a river flowing through it.
 8. This occurs when a river deposits water and sediment into a larger body of water.
 9. Process where rock is dissolved, worn down, or broken down into smaller and smaller pieces.
