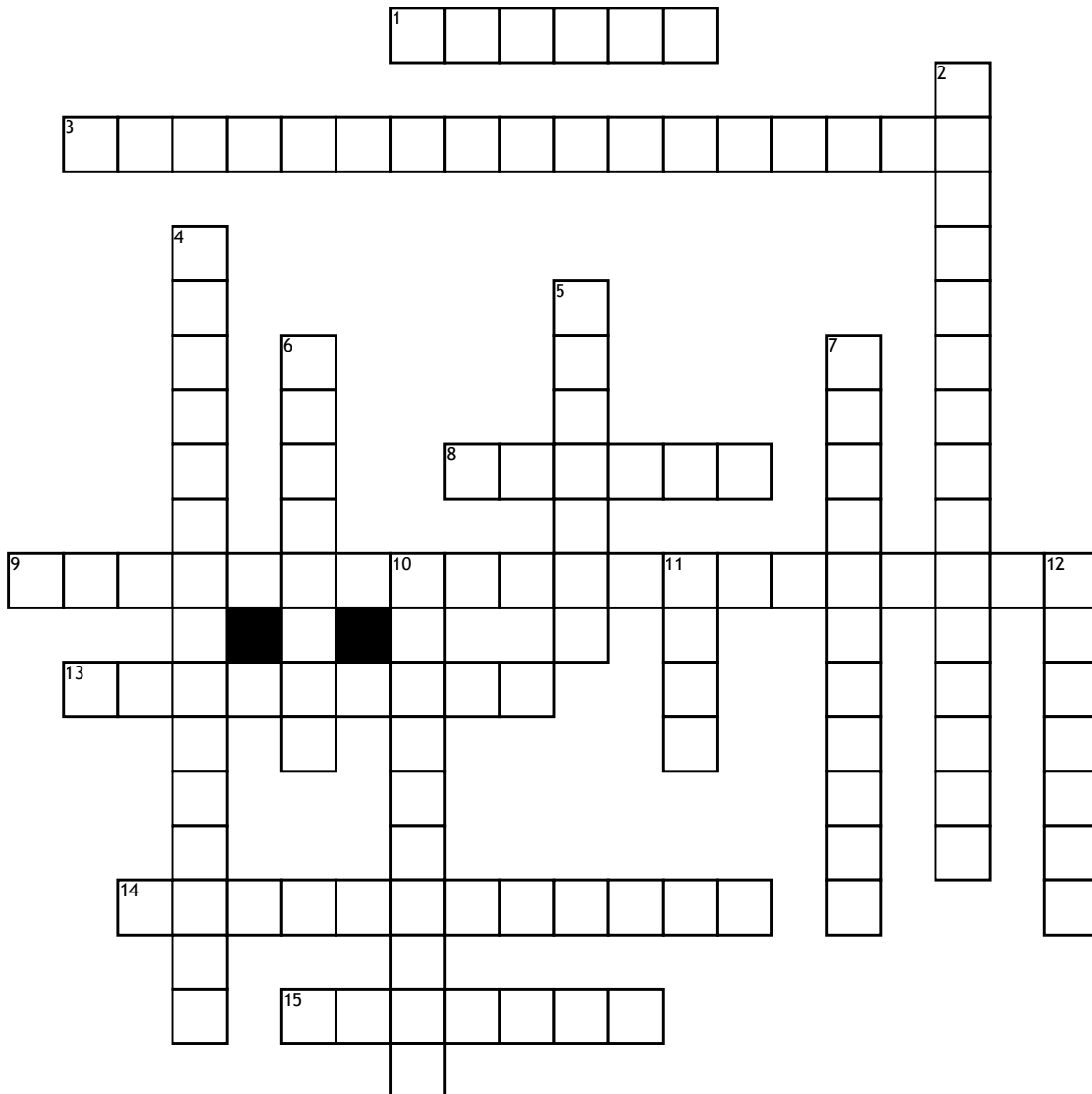


Earth's Structure
