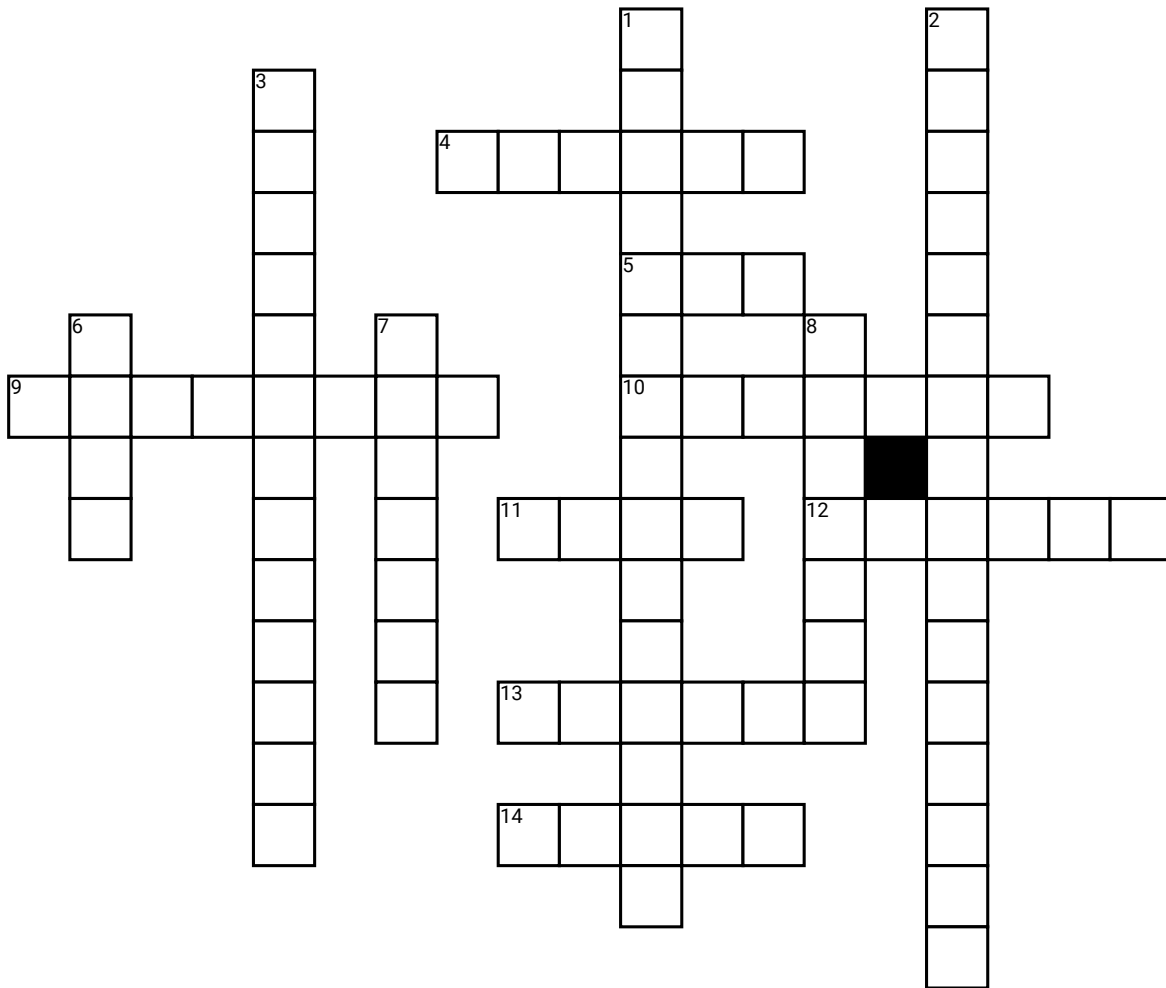


Easter Trivia Crossword Puzzle
