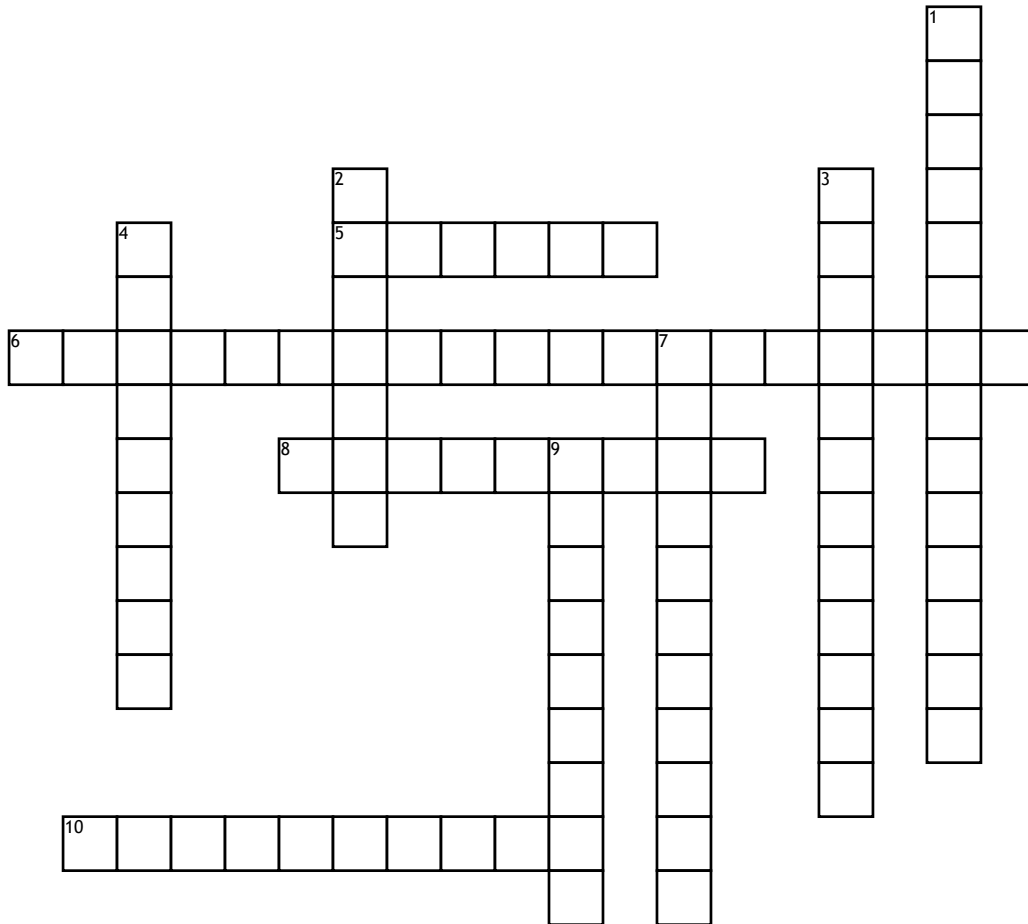


# Ecological footprint crossword
