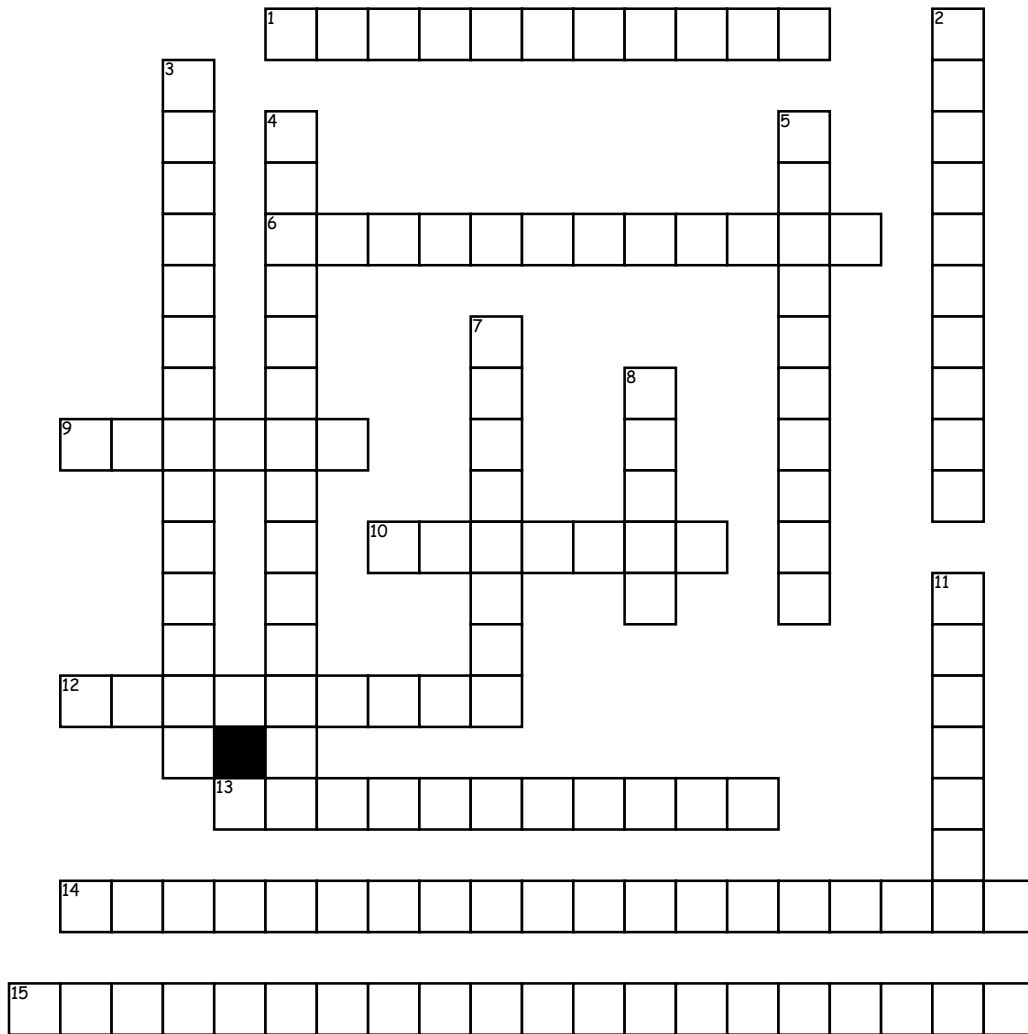


Ecology Crossword puzzle
