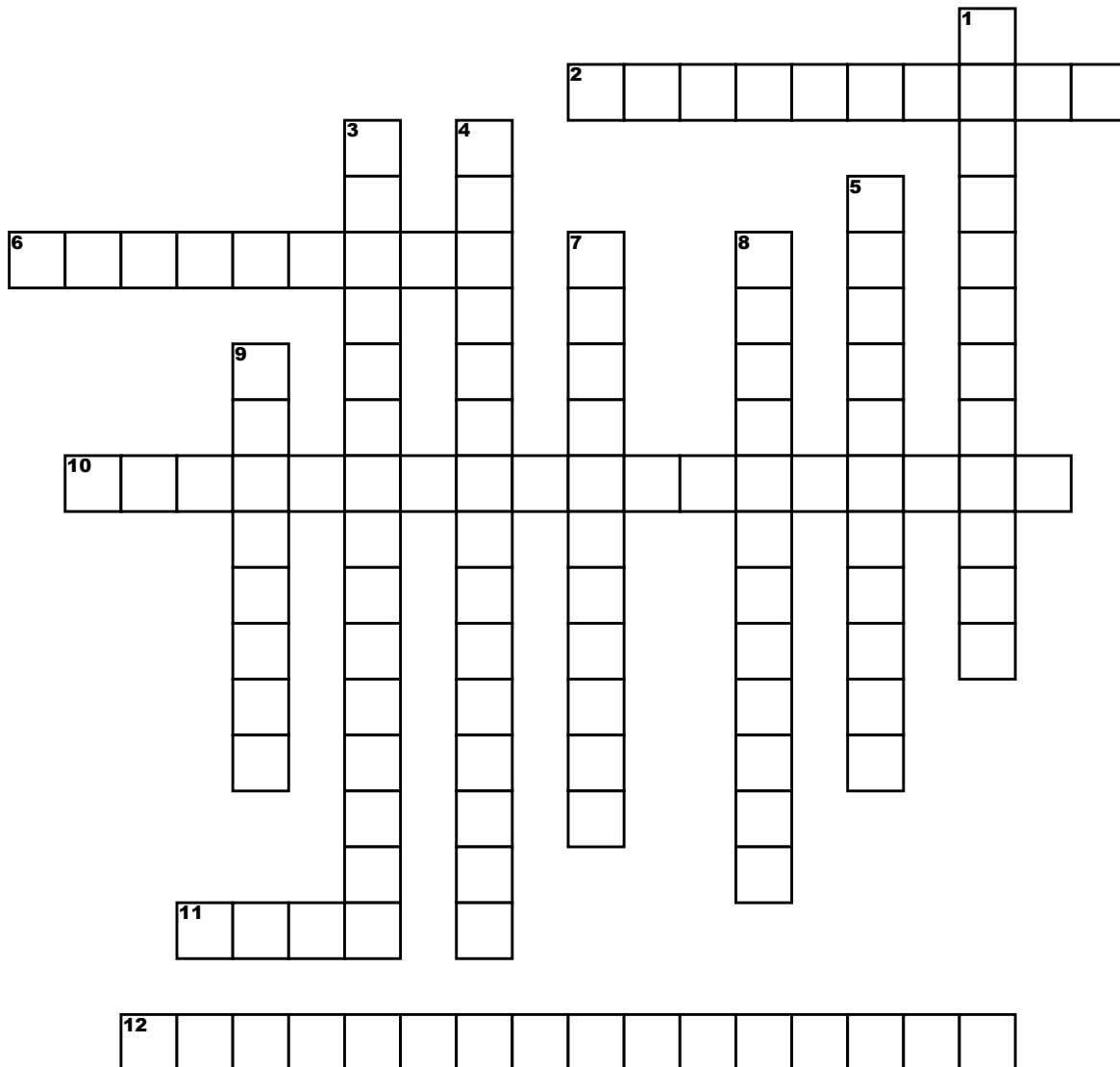

- 2.** Harmful relationship between 2 species in which one injures or harms the other while extracting a resource/food/energy
- 6.** A relationship between two or more species in which both (all) benefit.
- 10.** The idea that all living things are linked to one another in a complex way
- 11.** The hunted, could be another carnivore, omnivore, or herbivore

- 12.** The threshold or maximum range at which a given ecosystem/habitat can support specific species based on availability or resources (water, nutrients, living space, etc.)

- 1.** Variety of life forms in one given area/biome/habitat; the higher the biodiversity, the more stable and ecosystem can be because there is a higher variety of relationship at play.
- 3.** The apex or final stage of a given community.

- 4.** Characteristics that control population growth: availability of water, food, space, mates, genetic diversity, disease, etc.
- 5.** The process by which carbon moves through earth's living systems
- 7.** The act of seeking the same resource for survival, some carnivores overlap in terms of their prey
- 8.** Relationship between 2 species where one benefits, but the other is not impacted/affected
- 9.** The hunter, the carnivore
