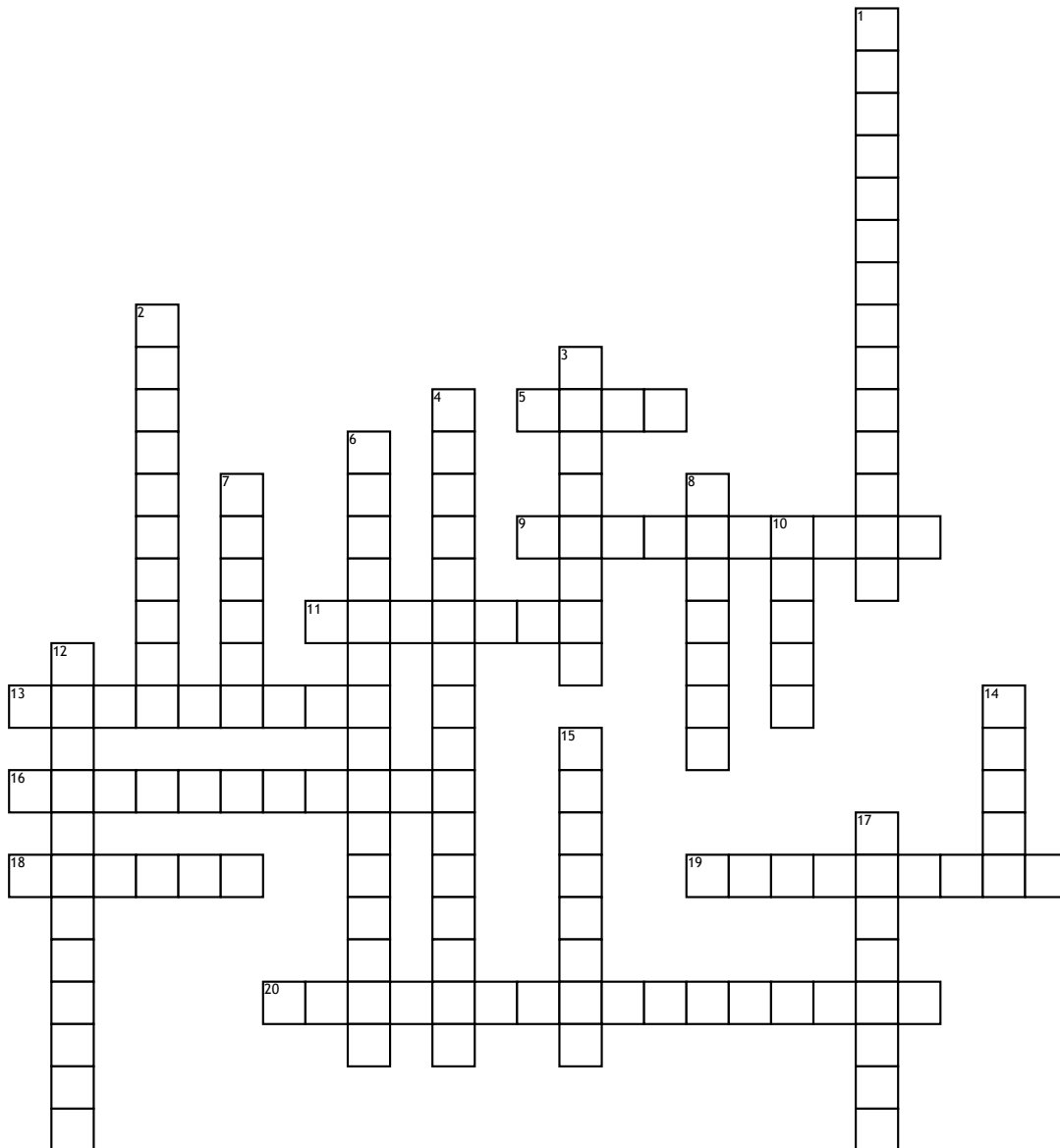


Economic Crossword
