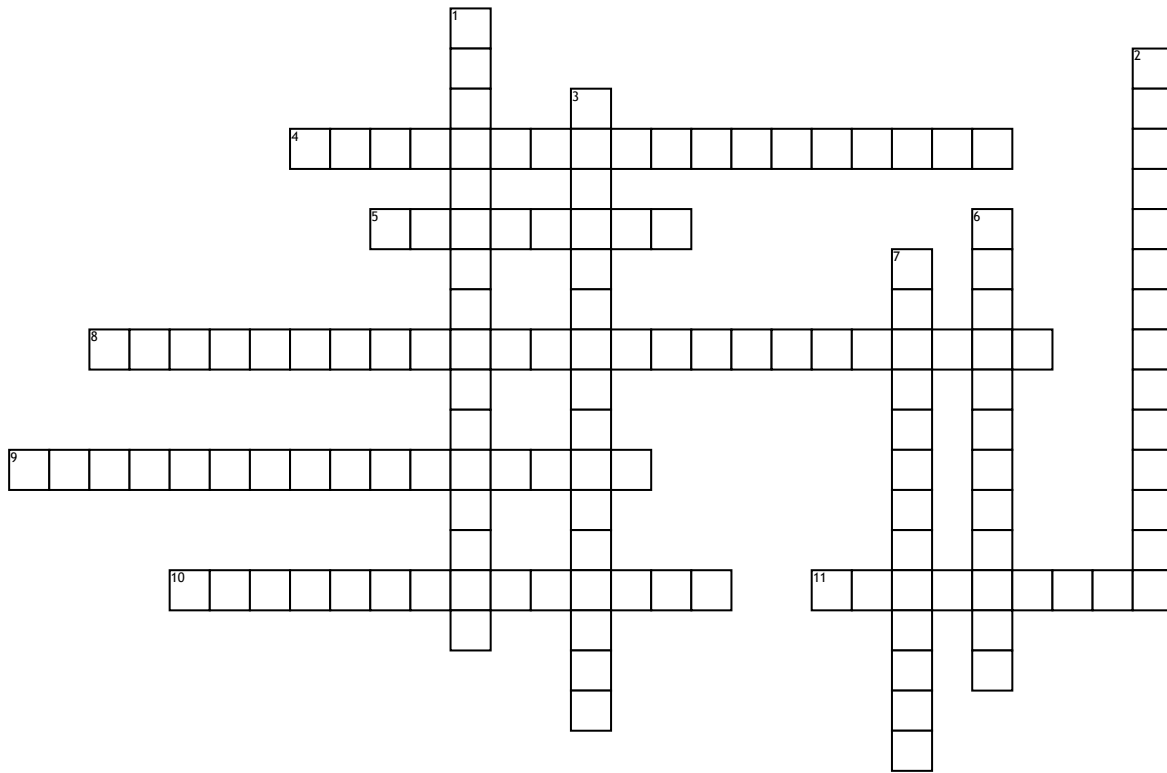

4. an original economic system in which traditions, customs, and beliefs help shape the goods and the services the economy produces
5. is the fundamental economic problem of having seemingly unlimited human wants in a world of limited resources

10. an economy in which production, investment, prices, and incomes are determined centrally by a government.

2. the personnel of a business or organization, especially when regarded as a significant asset

7. an economic system in which economic decisions and the pricing of goods and services are guided solely by the aggregate interactions of a country's individual citizens and businesses
