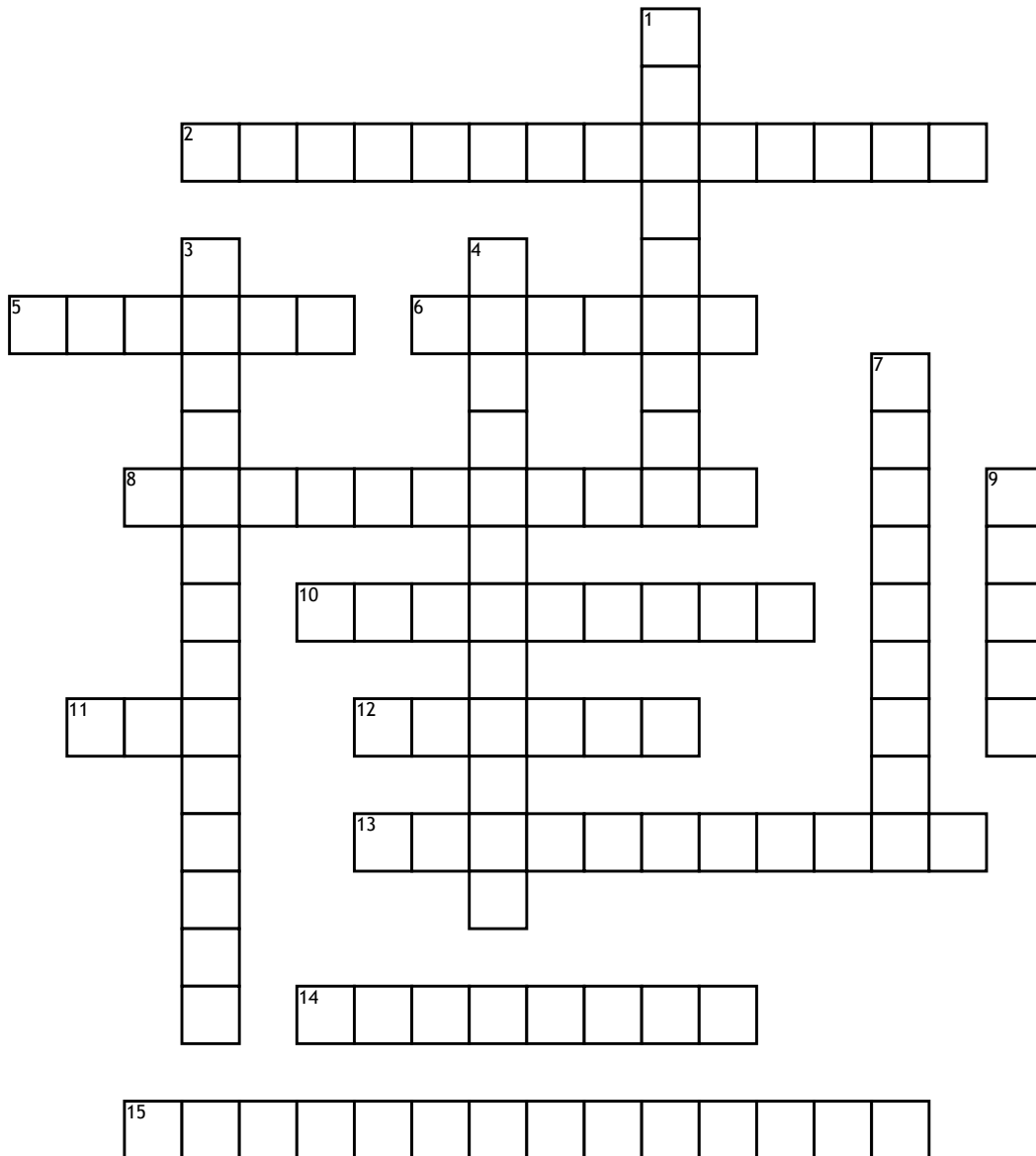


Economics Crossword Puzzle
