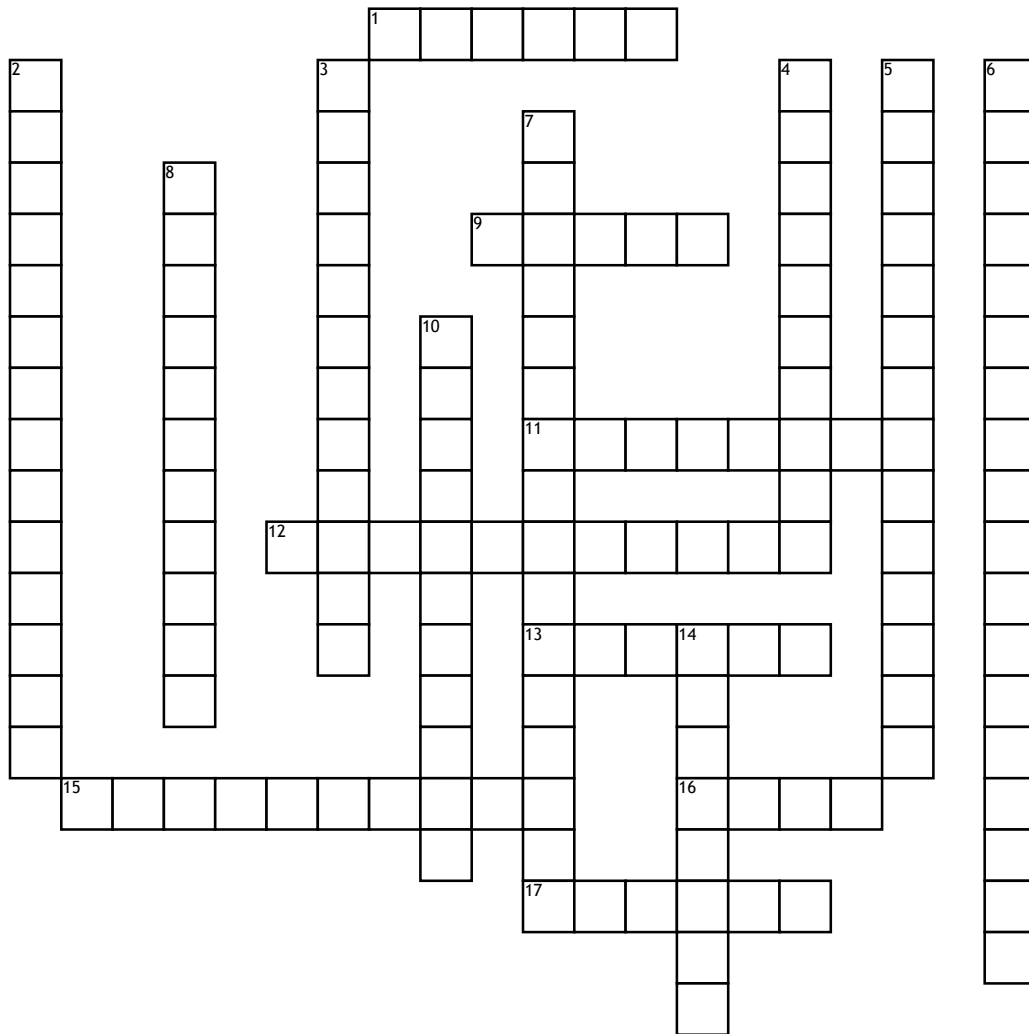


Economics Crossword
