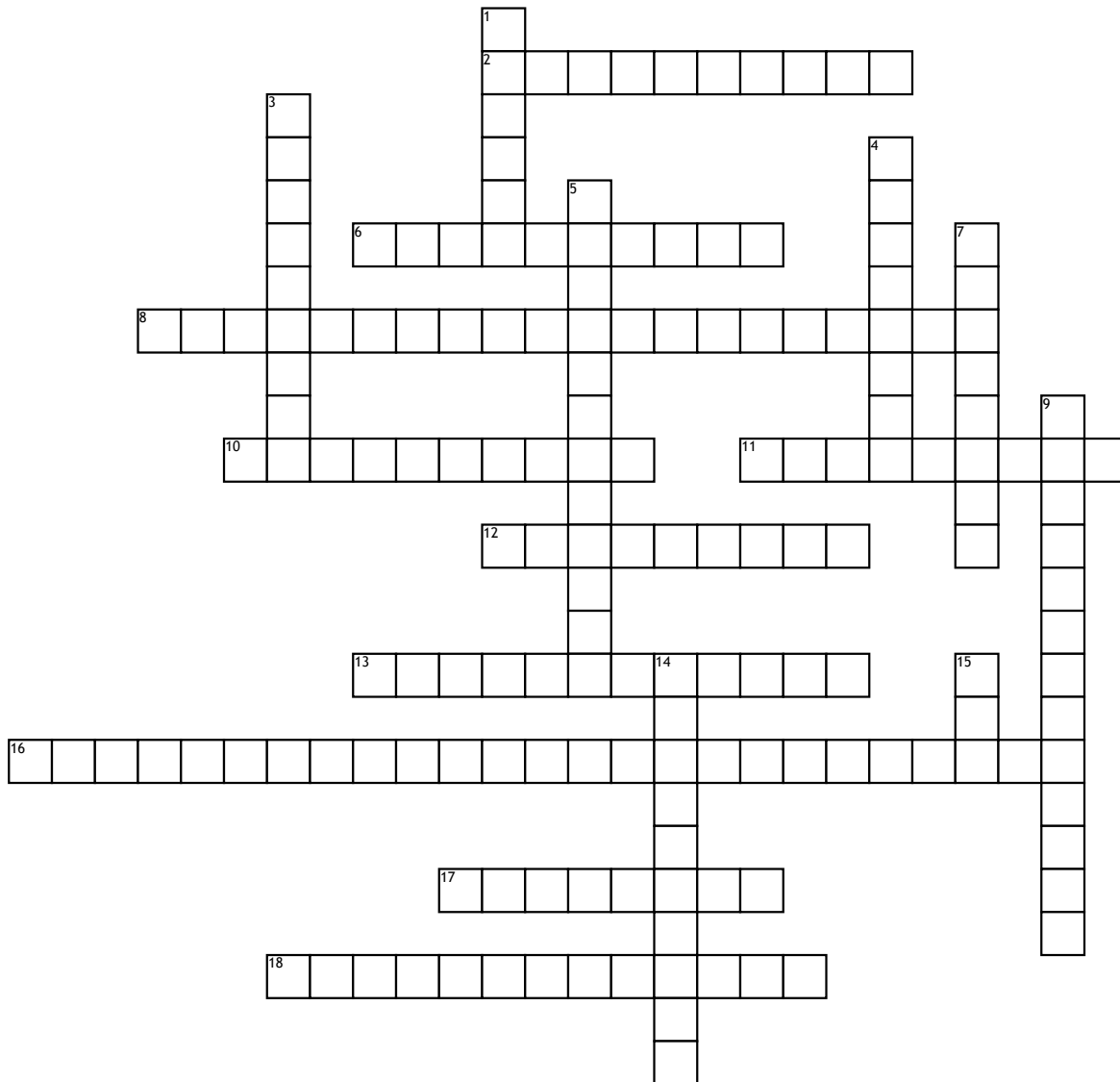


Effects of Alcohol
