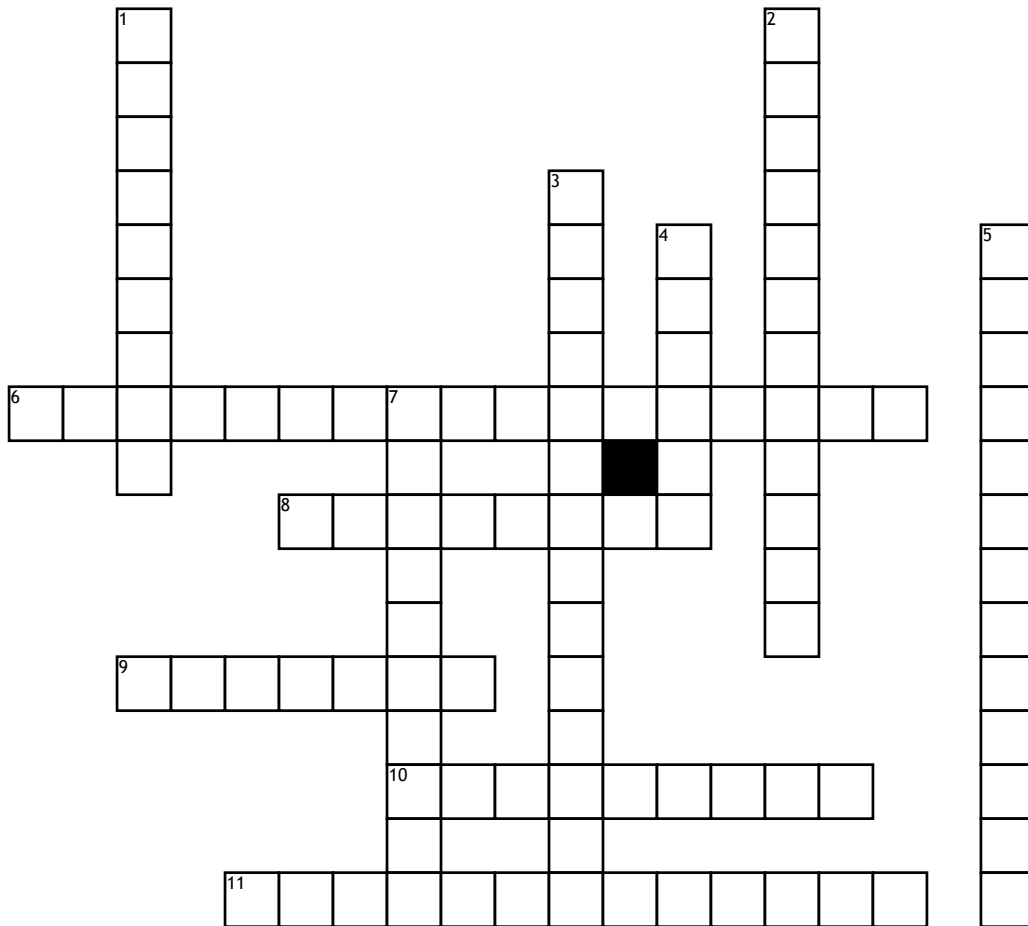

- 1. altar set up to honor and remember an ancestor.
- 2. cemetery; cemeteries are often cleaned and decorated prior to the celebration.
- 3. yellow marigolds often referred to as “el flor del muerto”
- 4. Candle; candles are often lit in cemeteries.
- 5. Bread of the Dead. A sweet roll which is traditionally baked as a part of the celebration
- 7. representation of a skull used on Day of the Dead.
