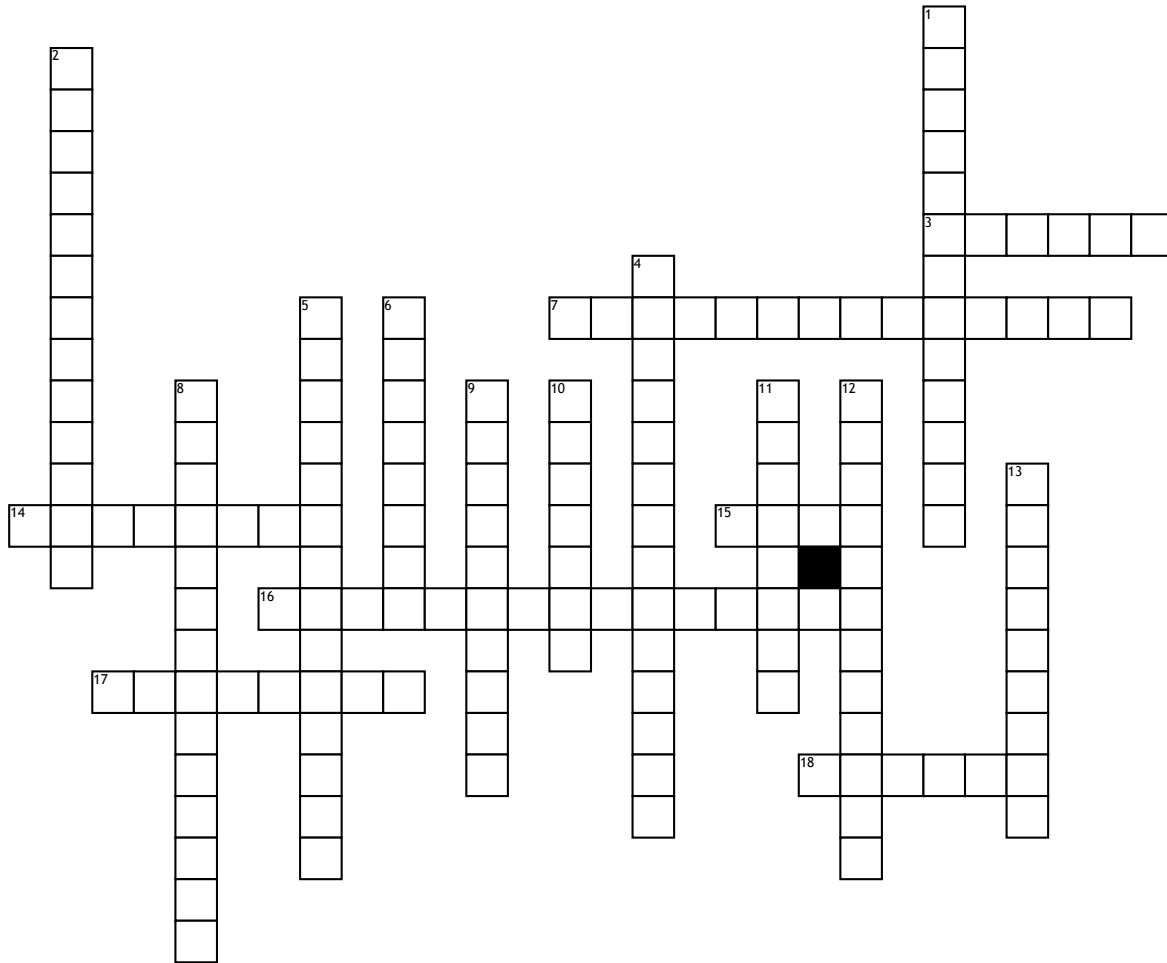

1. a type of state in which one political party has the right to form the government, usually based on the existing constitution.
