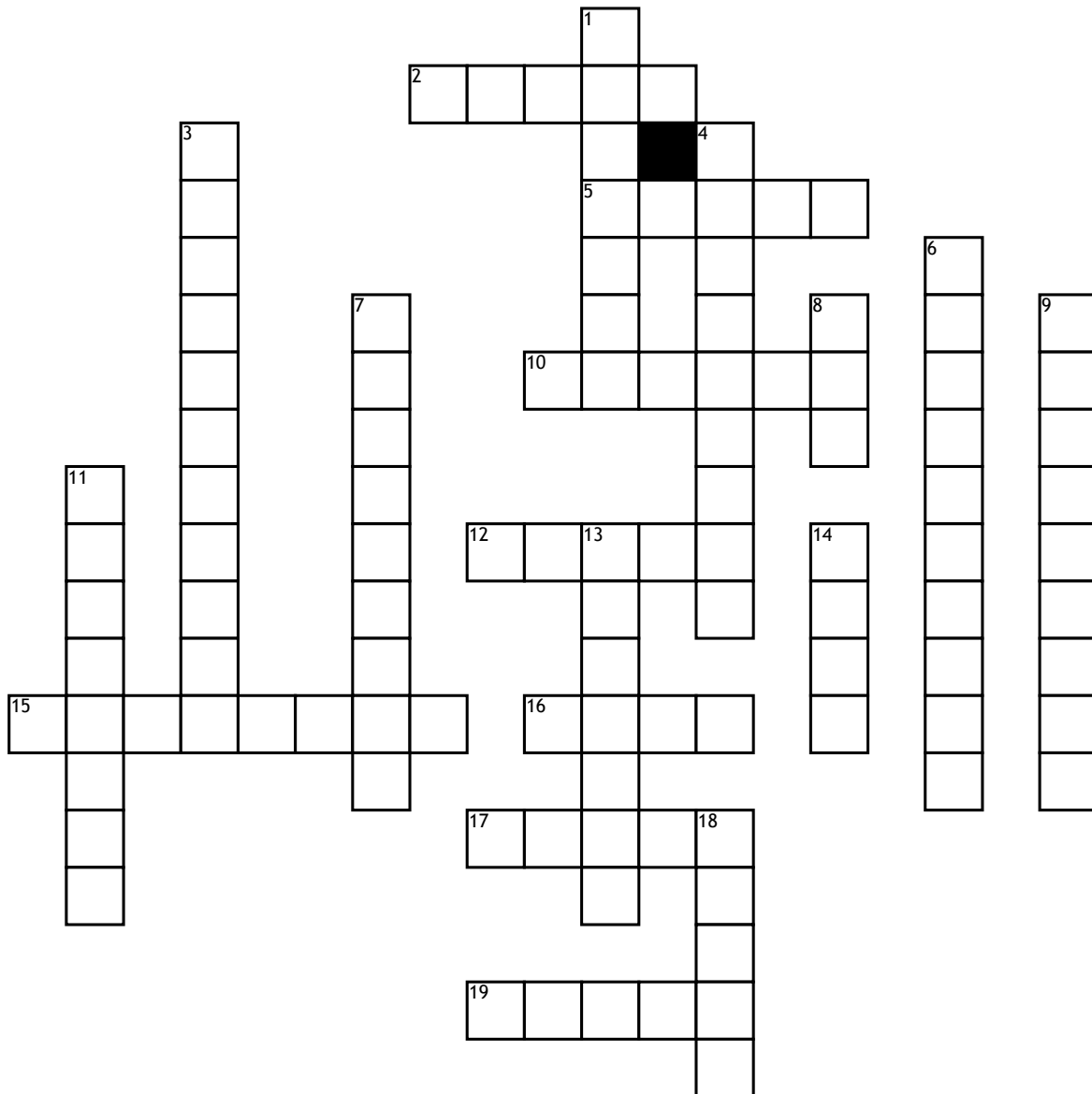


# Electrical Safety
