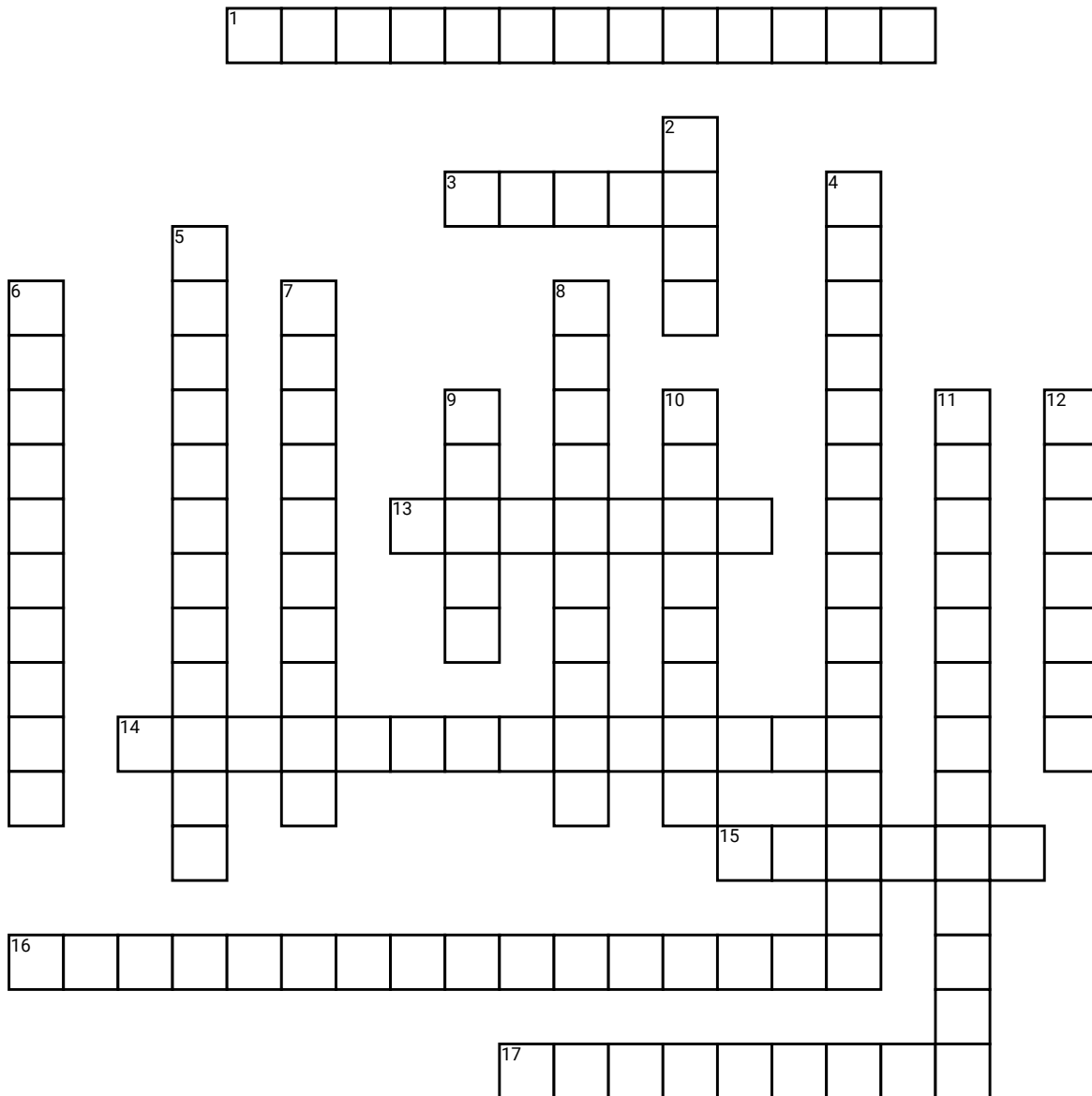


Elements of Fiction

1. events after the climax; loose ends tied up
 3. form of fiction; longer; more complicated plot
 13. time and place in which the events of a story take place
 14. less important character; helps plot move along
 15. turning point, suspense reaches a peak, outcome of conflict is decided
 16. the reason a character does what they do

17. person, animal, or imaginary creature in a story

2. sequence of events in a story; author's plan for what happens and to whom
 4. more permanent qualities; personality
 5. plot thickens, suspense builds, central conflict unfolds
 6. conflict is resolved or not
 7. "sets the stage"; background of the story, characters and setting introduced

8. form of fiction that revolves around a single idea; read in one sitting
 9. meaning, moral, message an author wants you to get from story
 10. problem between opposing forces in a story
 11. events centered around this character; most important
 12. writing that comes from the author's imagination; can be inspired by real events or completely made up
