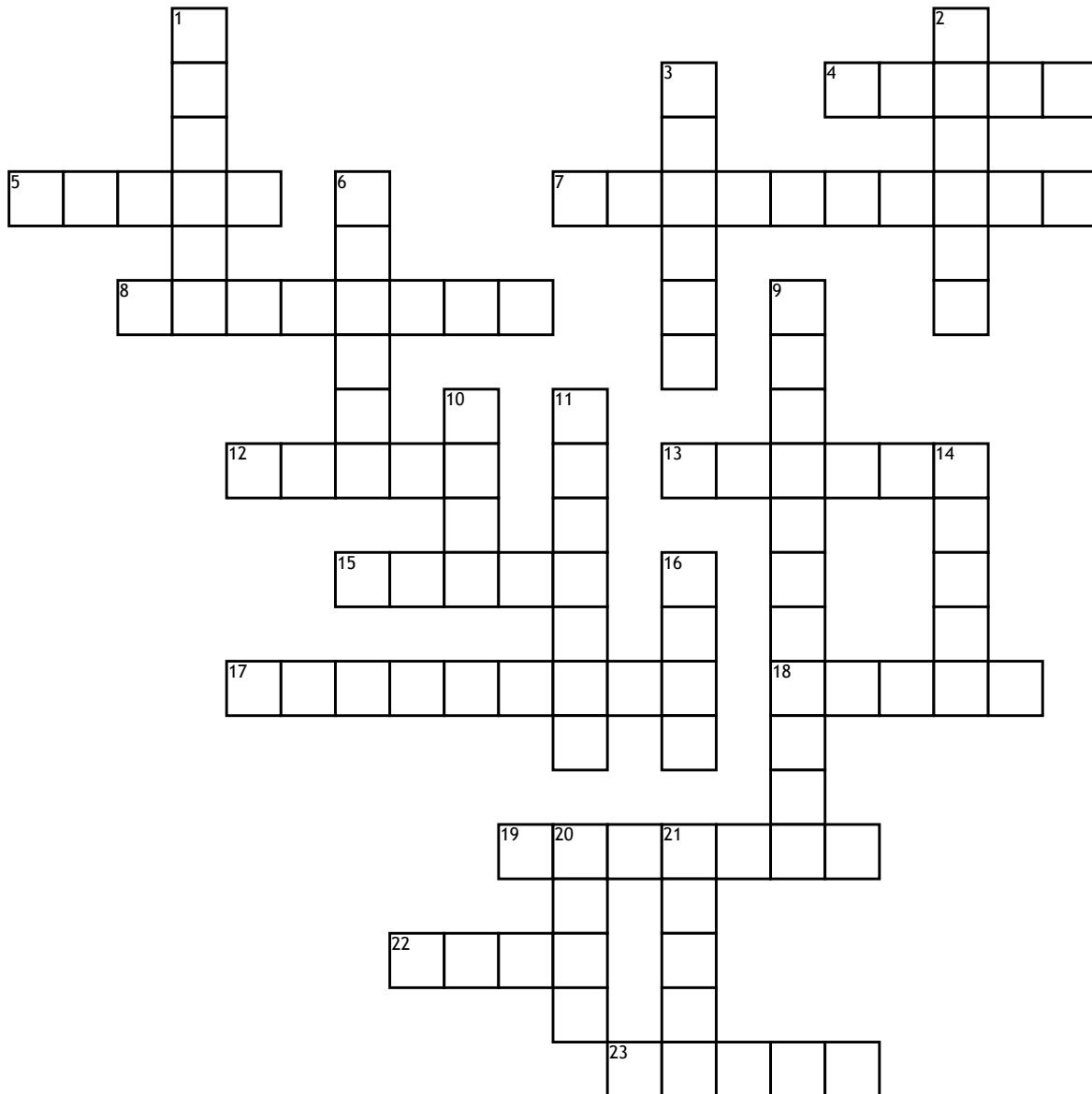


Elements of Music

4. how high or low the note is

18. the higher of the two voices usually notated on the bottom staff of vocal music

19. the sound of two or more notes heard simultaneously

23. The instrument family containing trumpets, horns, trombones, and tubas

1. a linear succession of musical tones that the listener perceives as a single entity

2. the instrument family that contains violins, violas, cellos, and bass

6. the character or quality of a musical sound or voice; also known as tone color

9. a disturbance or interruption of the regular flow of rhythm or a placement of rhythmic stresses or accents where they wouldn't normally occur

10. the absence of sound or a musical symbol that marks the absence of a note
