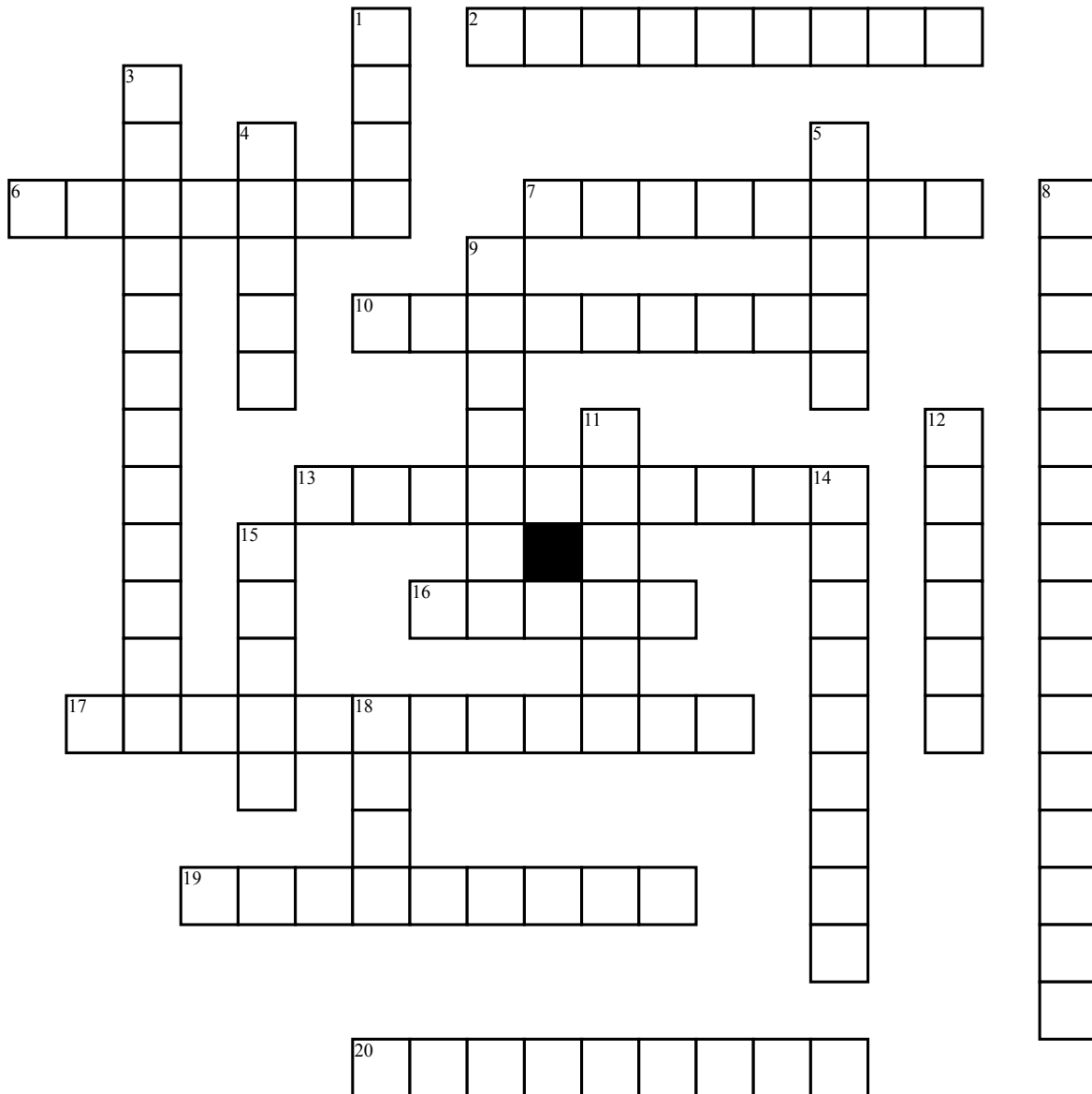

# Elements of Poetry



## Across

- 2. poem that does not use a fixed pattern
- 6. narrative poem, usually a folk tale or legend, that is often sung
- 7. figure of speech that compares two unlike objects or ideas without using the words "like" or "as"
- 10. the use of a symbol (words, objects, or actions) to represent something other than itself
- 13. repeated use of a word, phrase, line, or stanza in a poem
- 16. short poem expressing strong feelings or emotions of the speaker, almost musical
- 17. a word that sounds like its meaning or mimics a sound

- 19. use of exaggeration for effect or to emphasize a point
- 20. the overall organization of the lines of a poem

## Down

- 1. the emotions and feelings the poem creates for the reader or audience
- 3. the repeated use of the same consonant sound at the beginning of words
- 4. unrhymed poem consisting of 3 lines with each line having a 5-, 7-, and 5-syllable pattern
- 5. pattern of correspondence of the end sounds of each line of a stanza or poem; also correspondence of sounds other than at the ends of lines
- 8. giving human characteristics to an animal, non-living object, or idea

- 9. the use of words to create a vivid mental picture or physical sensation
- 11. figure of speech used to compare two different things using the words "like" or "as"
- 12. a series of lines grouped together and separated from other stanzas by a blank line
- 14. a poem that tells a story
- 15. the main message or central idea of a poem
- 18. the poet's feelings (attitude) toward the subject of the poem
