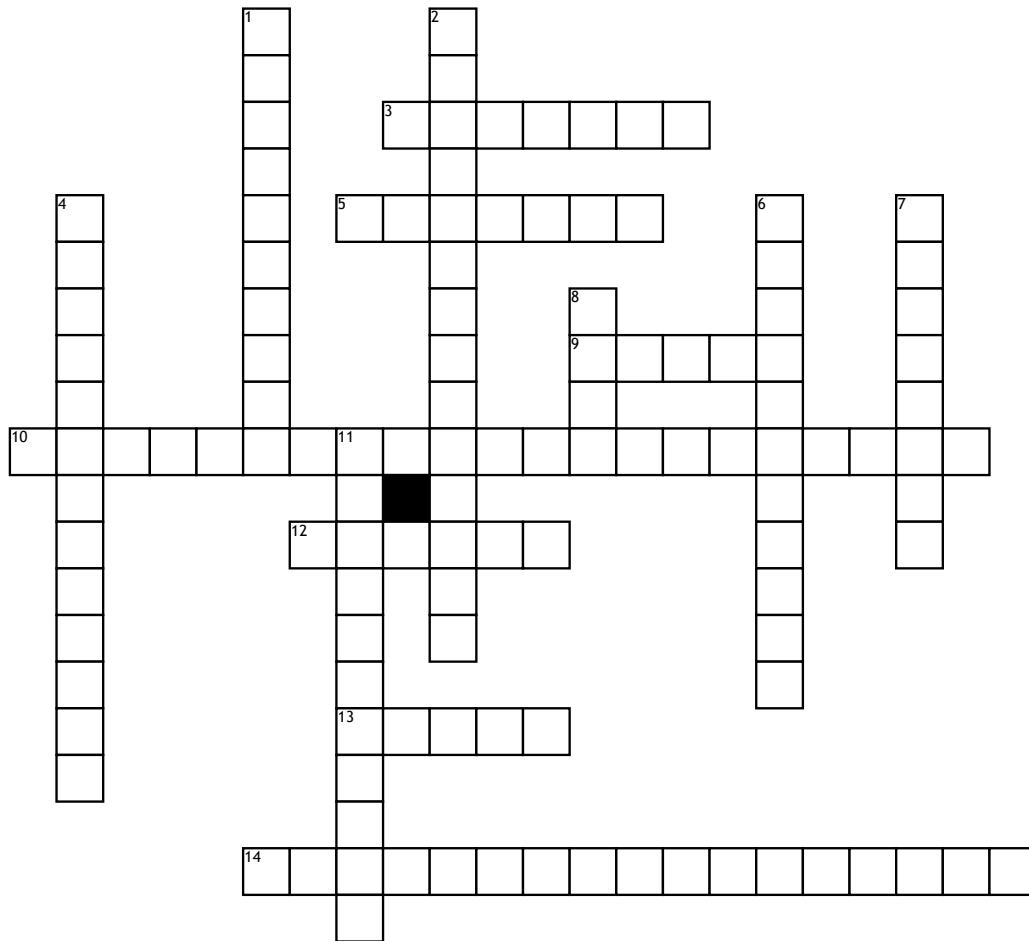


# Elements of Theatre and Acting
