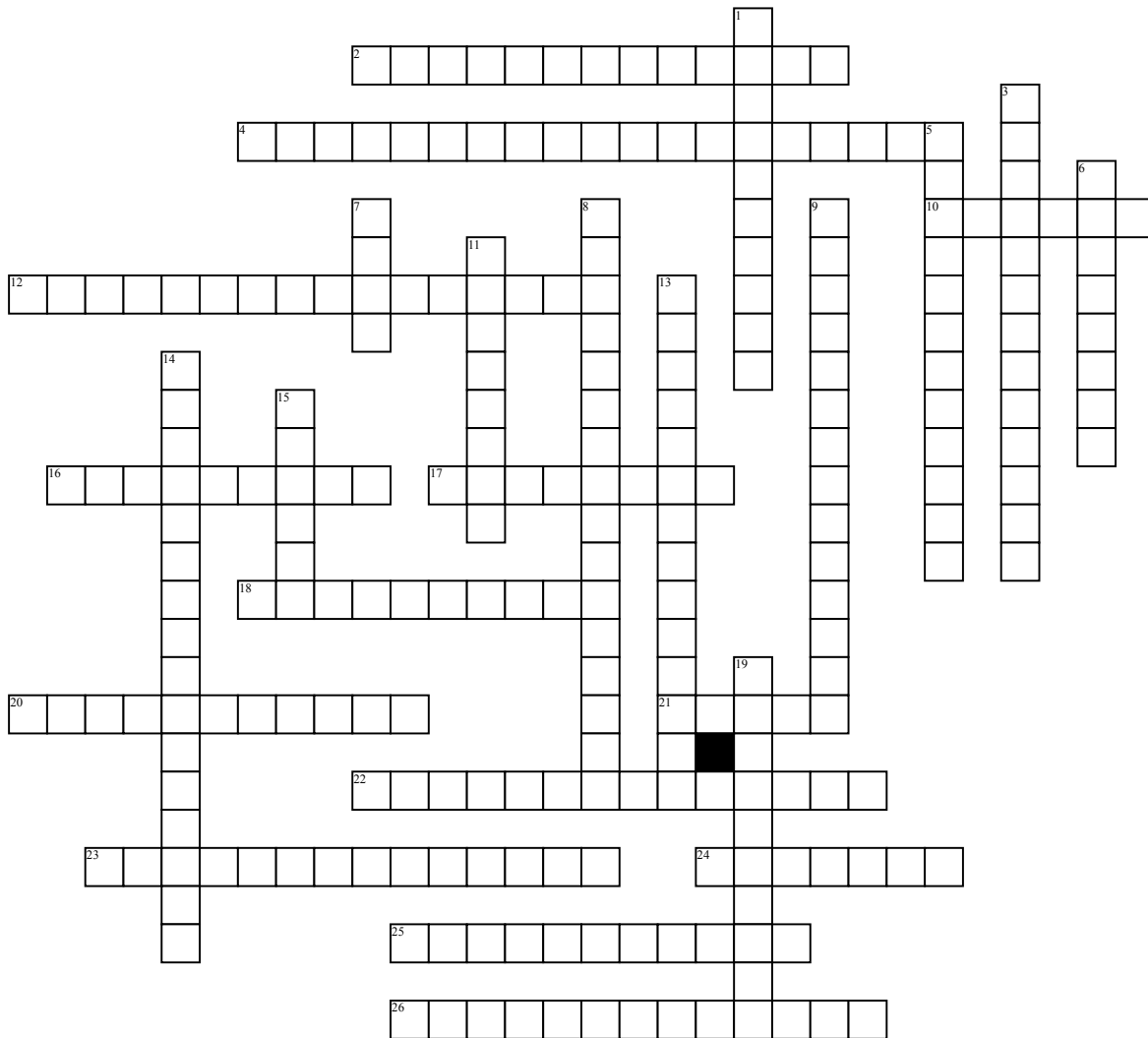


# Elements of a short story crossword puzzle
