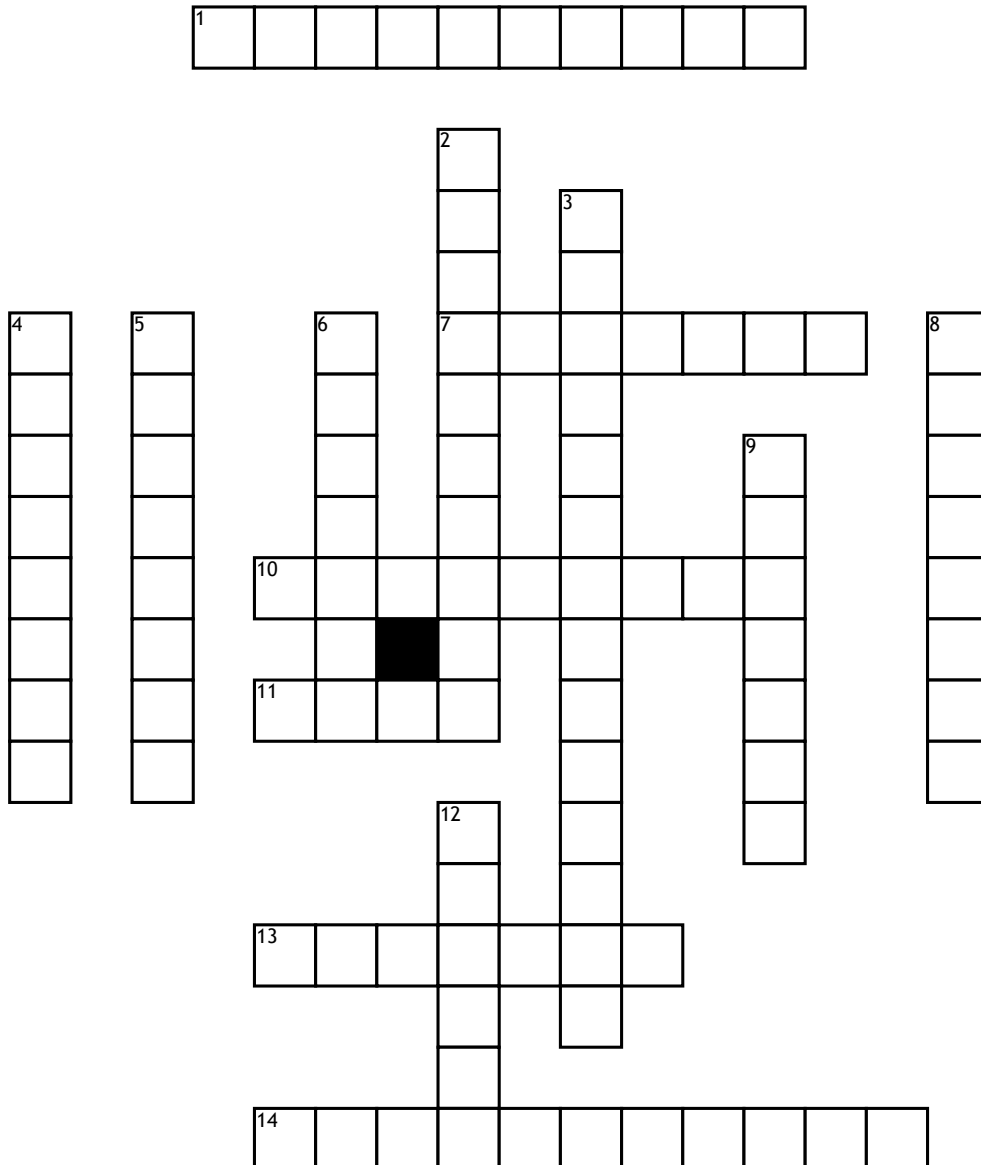


# Emergencies
