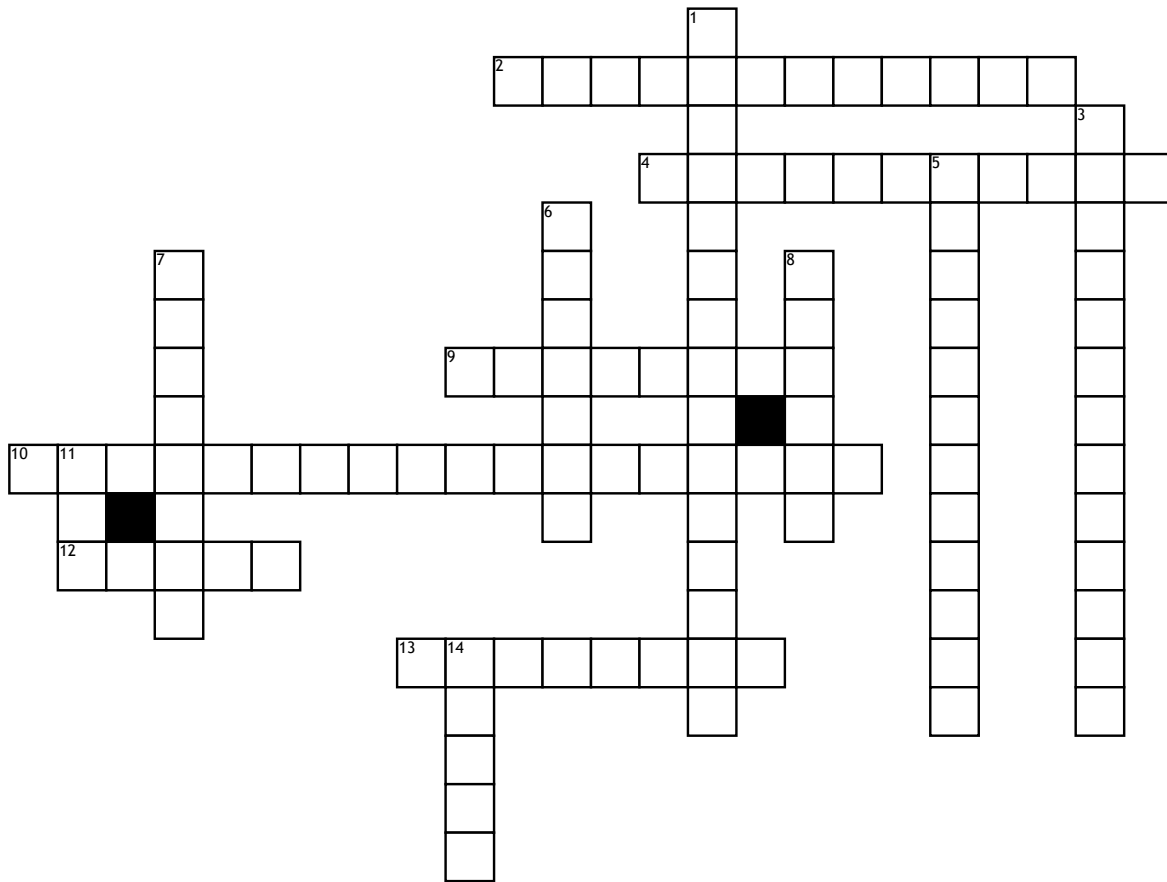


Endocrine/Reproductive Crossword
