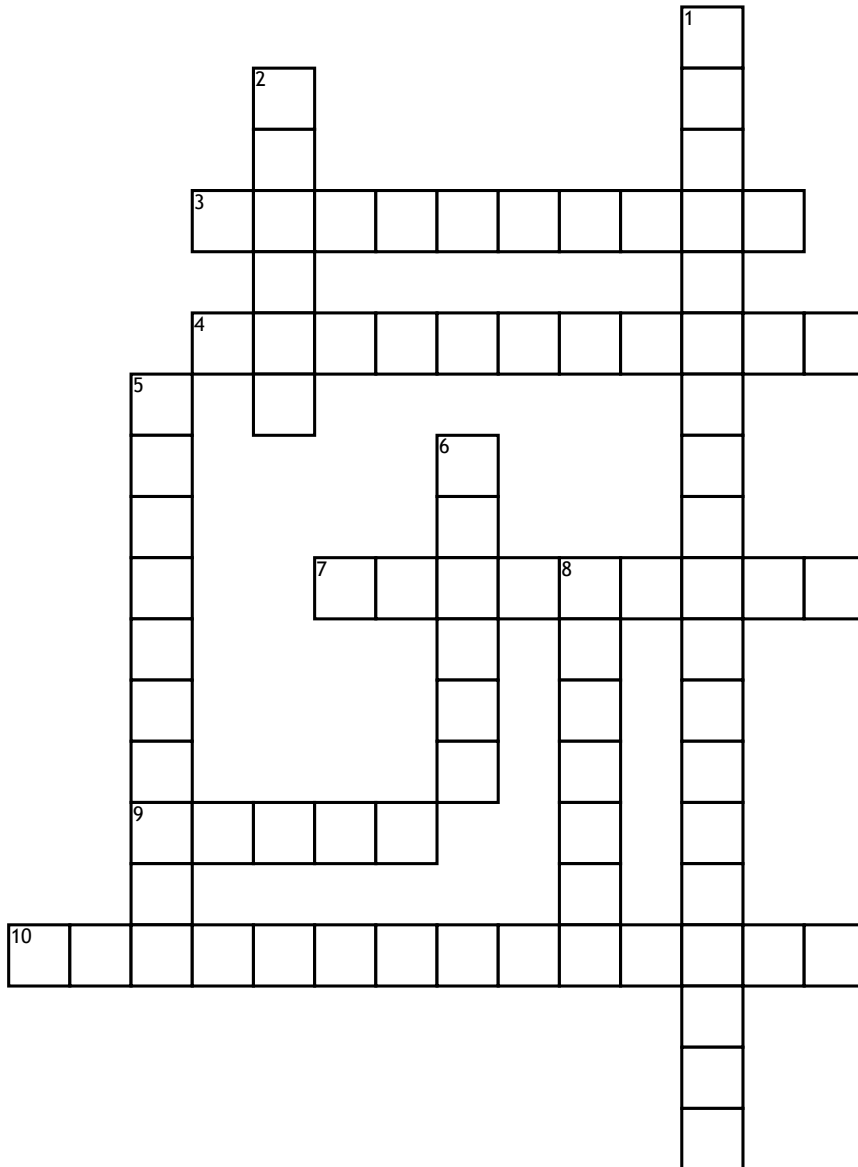

Endocrine Glands

3. Travel through the blood to reach all tissues and may affect far away target cells
4. The four small glands on the posterior surface of the thyroid gland
7. Hormone that stimulates milk production for lactation, targets breast secretory tissue, and in males helps to produce mature sperm
9. These hormones bind with cytoplasmic receptors to penetrate their target cells
10. The inactive storage form of thyroid hormones, called thyroglobulin

1. Hormone that is stimulated by corticotropin releasing hormone from the Hypothalamus and targets cortex of adrenal glands
2. Gland that produces melatonin which aids in sleep, jet lag, and may slow aging
5. Caused by an abnormally high production of GH in adulthood; bones thicken but do not grow in length
6. This hormone is released by the stimulation of the GHRH from the hypothalamus
8. Glands that sit near the tops of the kidneys
