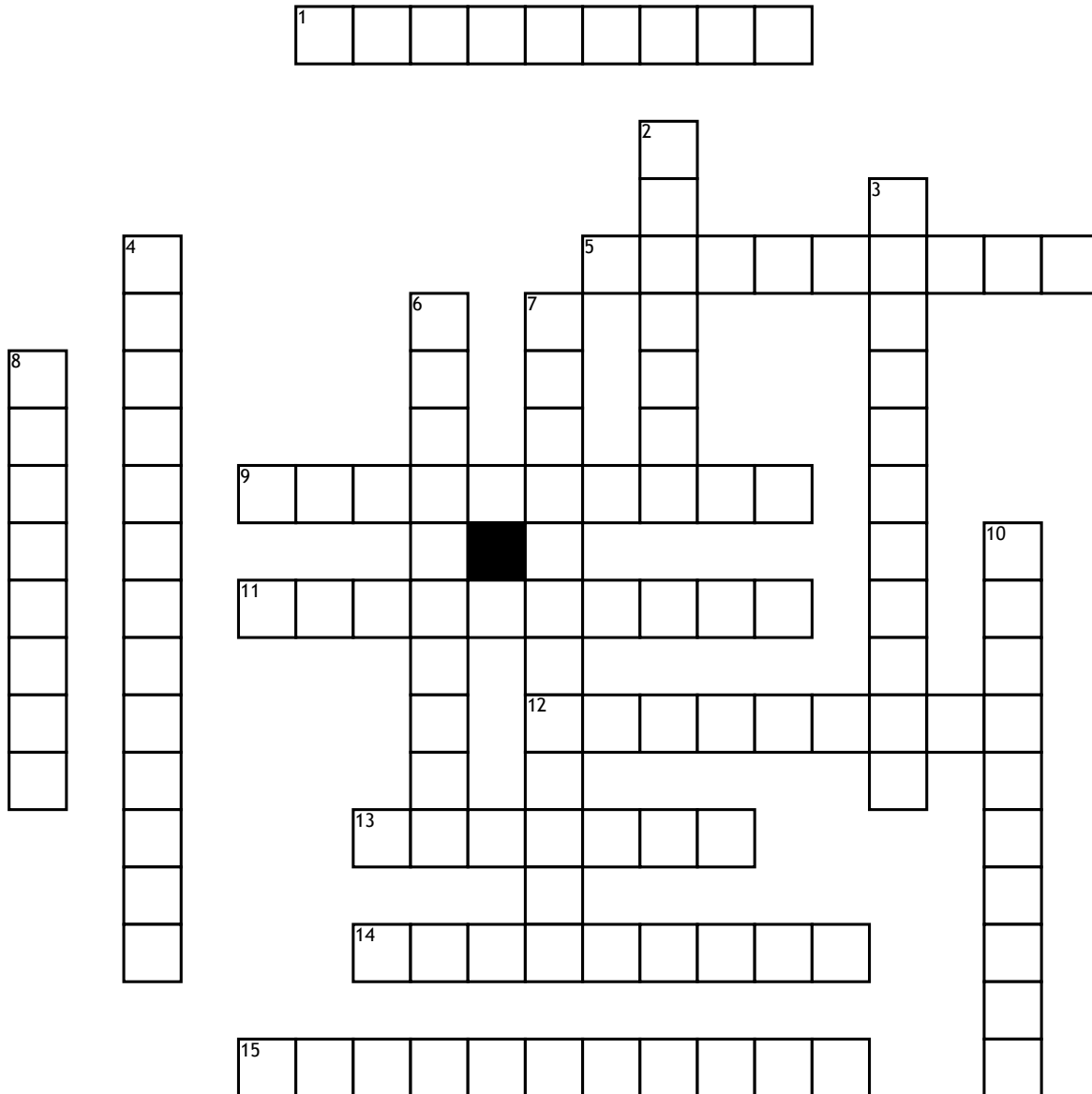


Endocrine Medical Terminology
