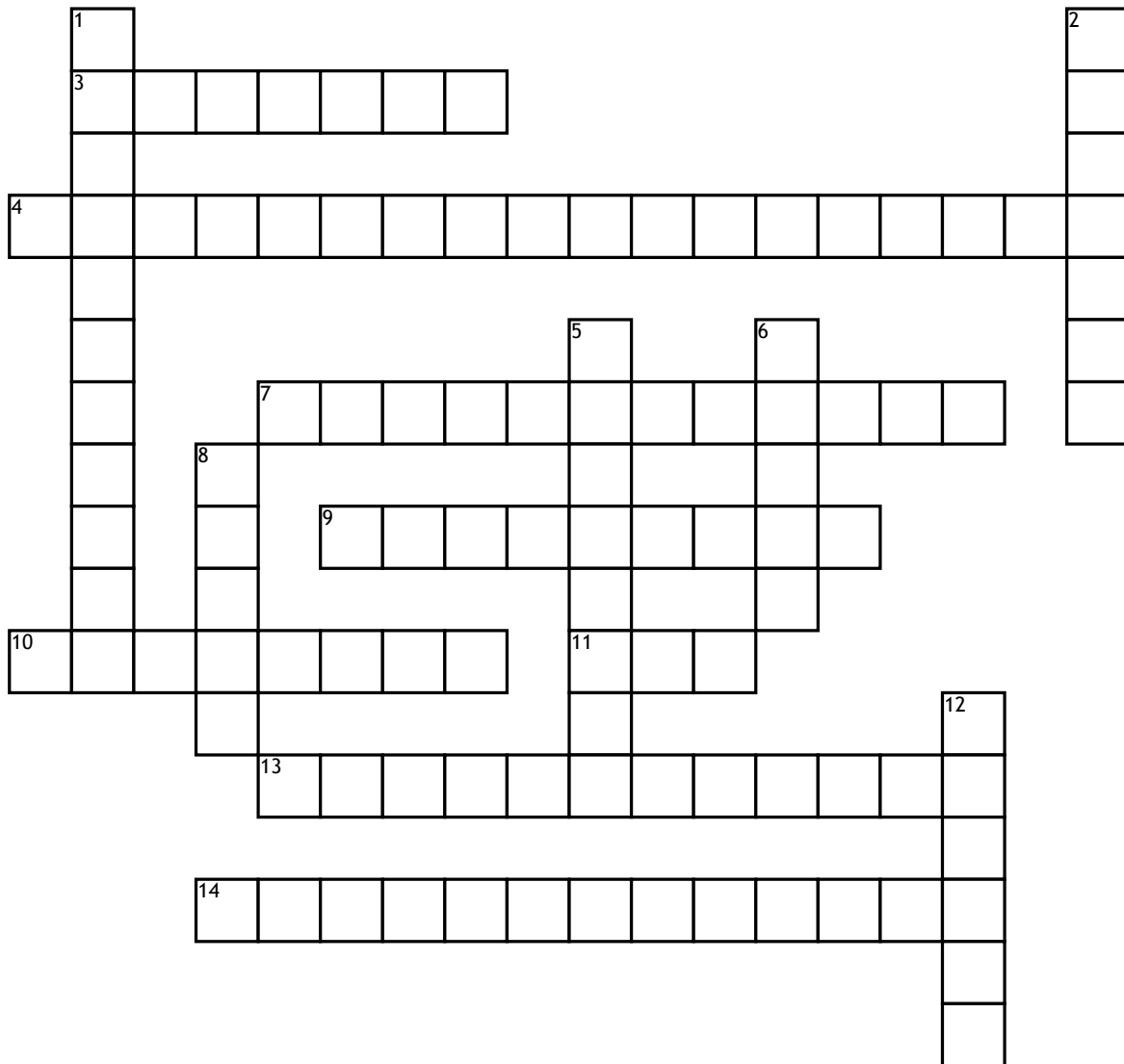


# Endocrine/ Reproductive Puzzle
