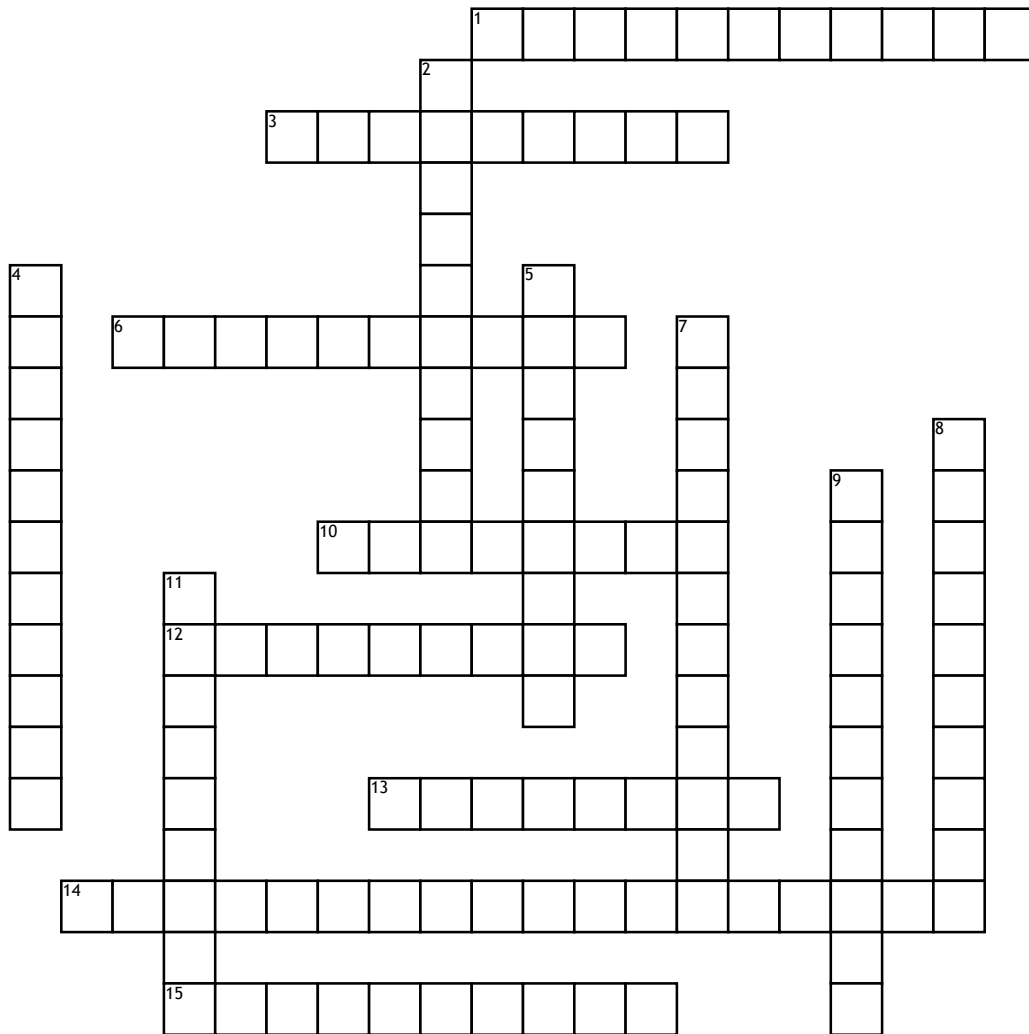


Endocrine System

 10. a substance deposited in bodily tissues as a store of carbohydrates. It is a polysaccharide that forms glucose on hydrolysis.

2. the treatment of disease by minute doses of natural substances that in a healthy person would produce symptoms of disease.

7. a chemical compound with the molecular formula $C_9H_9NO_3$ produced by the oxidation of adrenaline (epinephrine)
 8. abnormal growth of the hands, feet, and face, caused by overproduction of growth hormone by the pituitary gland.
 9. surgical removal of one or both testicles.
 11. a system for transmitting messages from a distance along a wire, especially one creating signals by making and breaking an electrical connection
