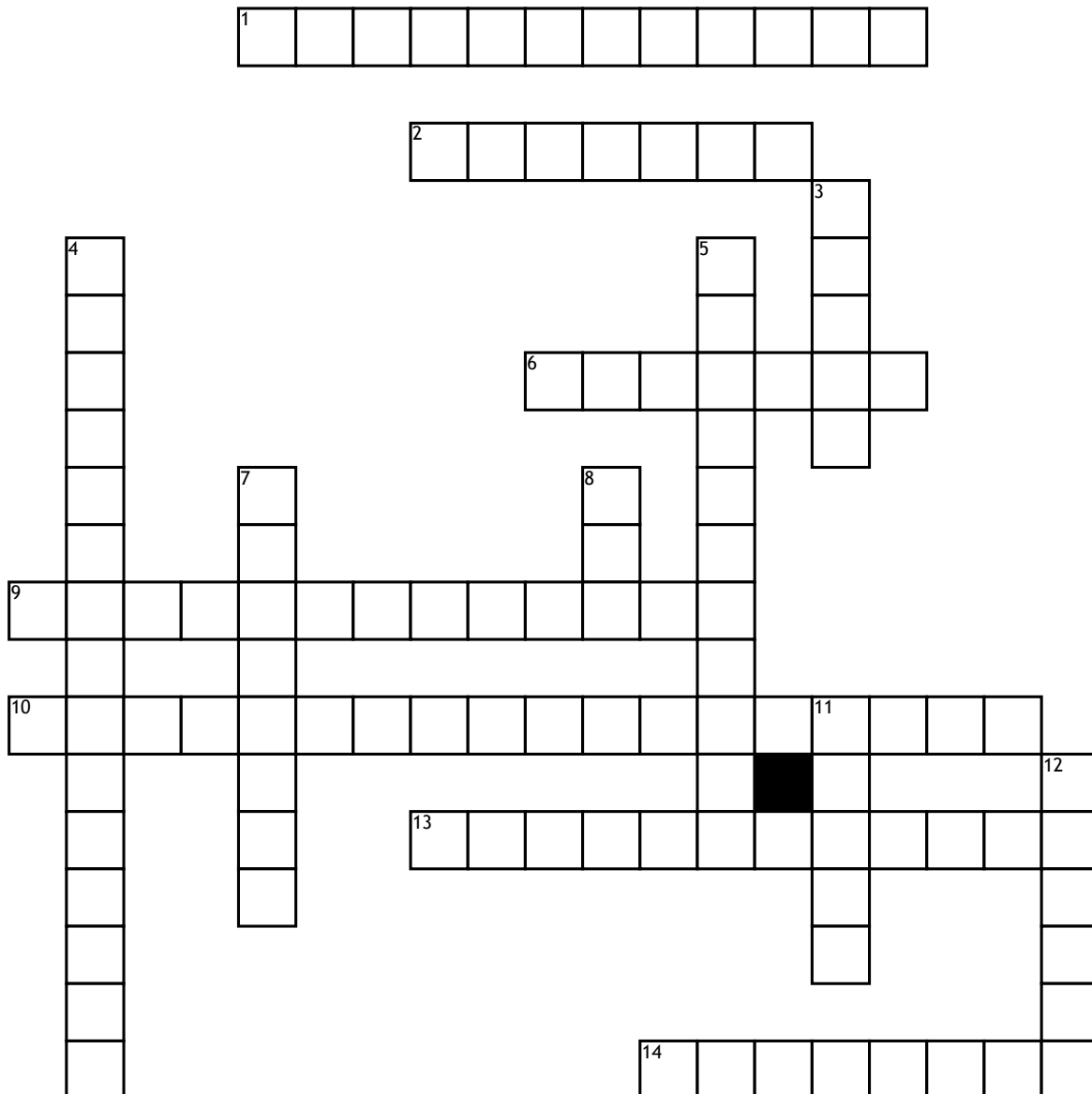


# Endocrine / Reproductive Crossword

1. Organ that sits on top of the kidney and produces adrenaline hormones.
2. An organ found inside females that releases eggs from the body and secretes estrogen and progesterone.
6. A chemical messenger made in one cell or tissue that causes a change in another cell or tissue elsewhere in the body.
9. A response that causes a person to either fight the situation or run away from it. The brain tells the adrenal gland to secrete adrenaline to create the fight or flight response during a stressful situation.

13. A hormone that is found in both males and females, but is way more prevalent in males. It causes males to create sperm and it is responsible for "males".

14. Organ that produces insulin to regulate blood sugar levels in the body.
