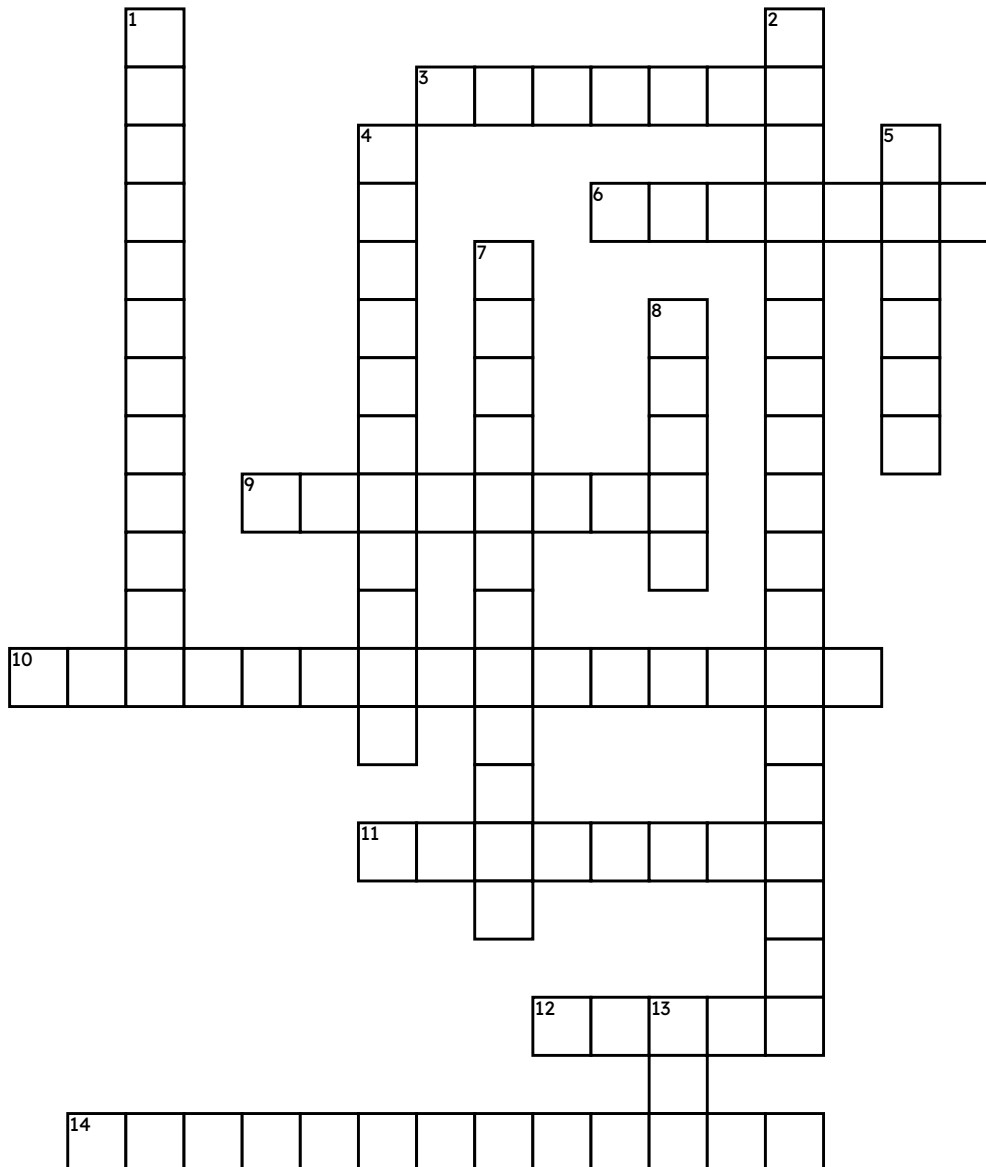


# Endocrine and Reproductive Systems
