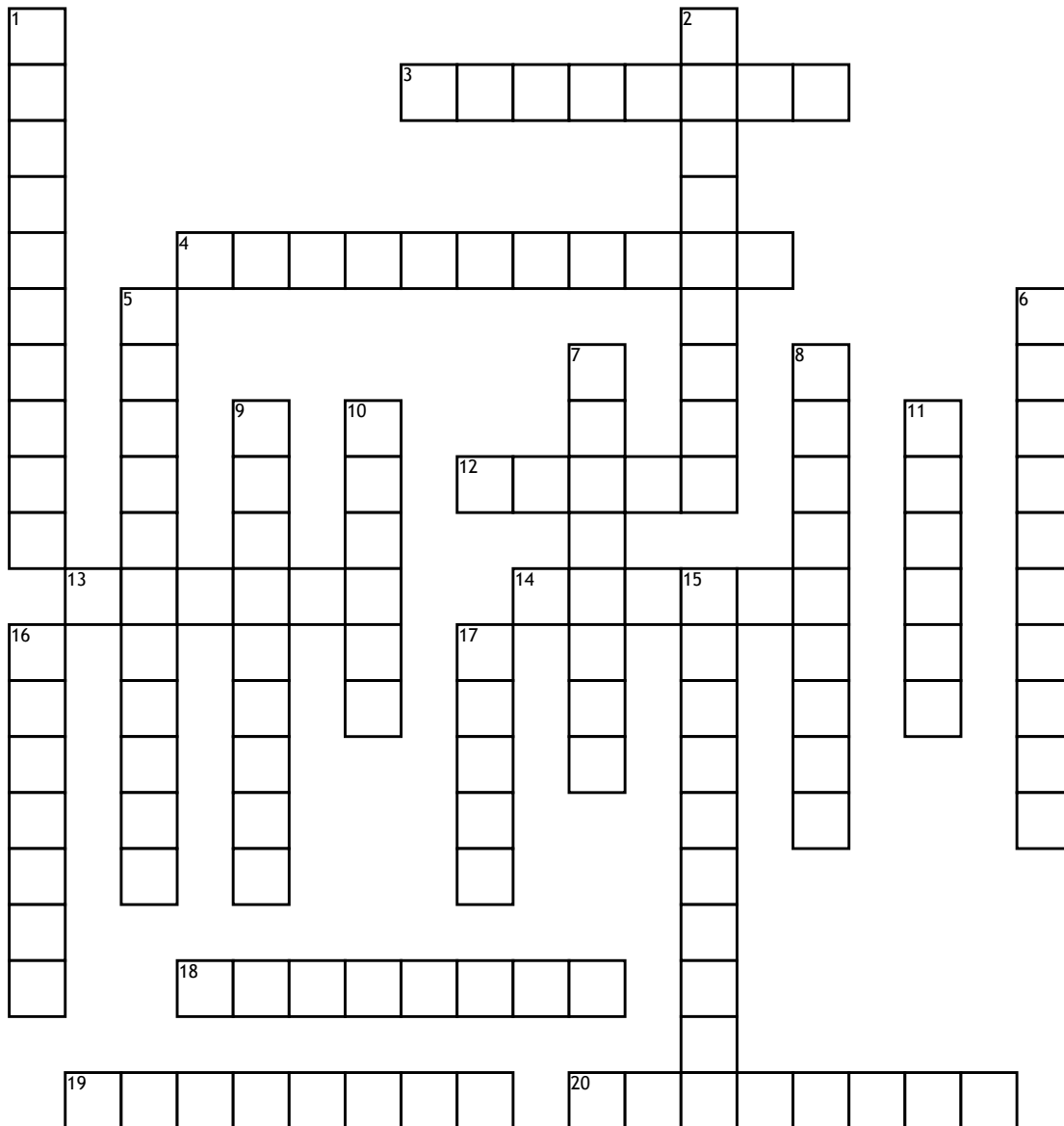


# English final cross word puzzle
