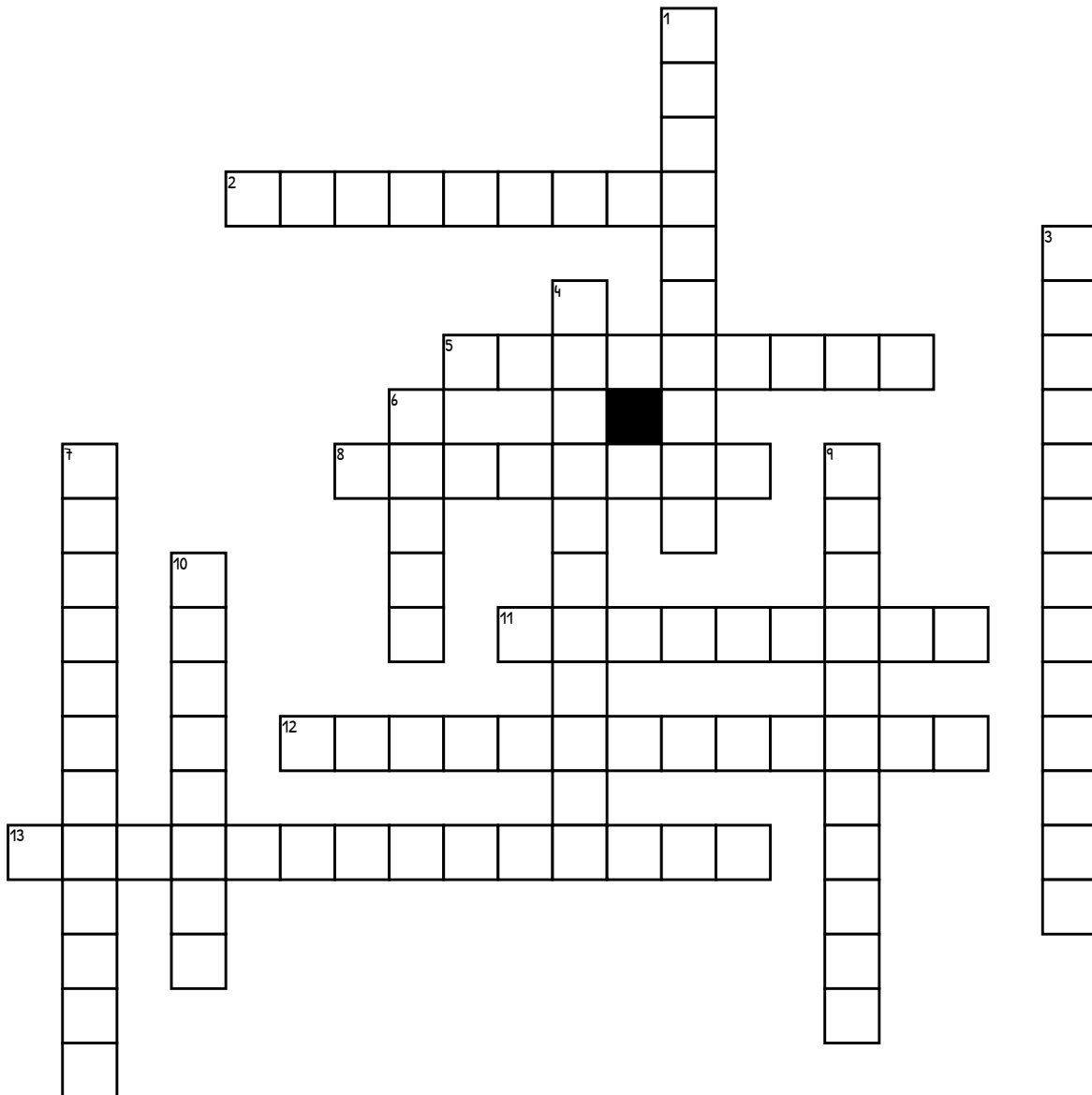


Enlightenment Puzzle
