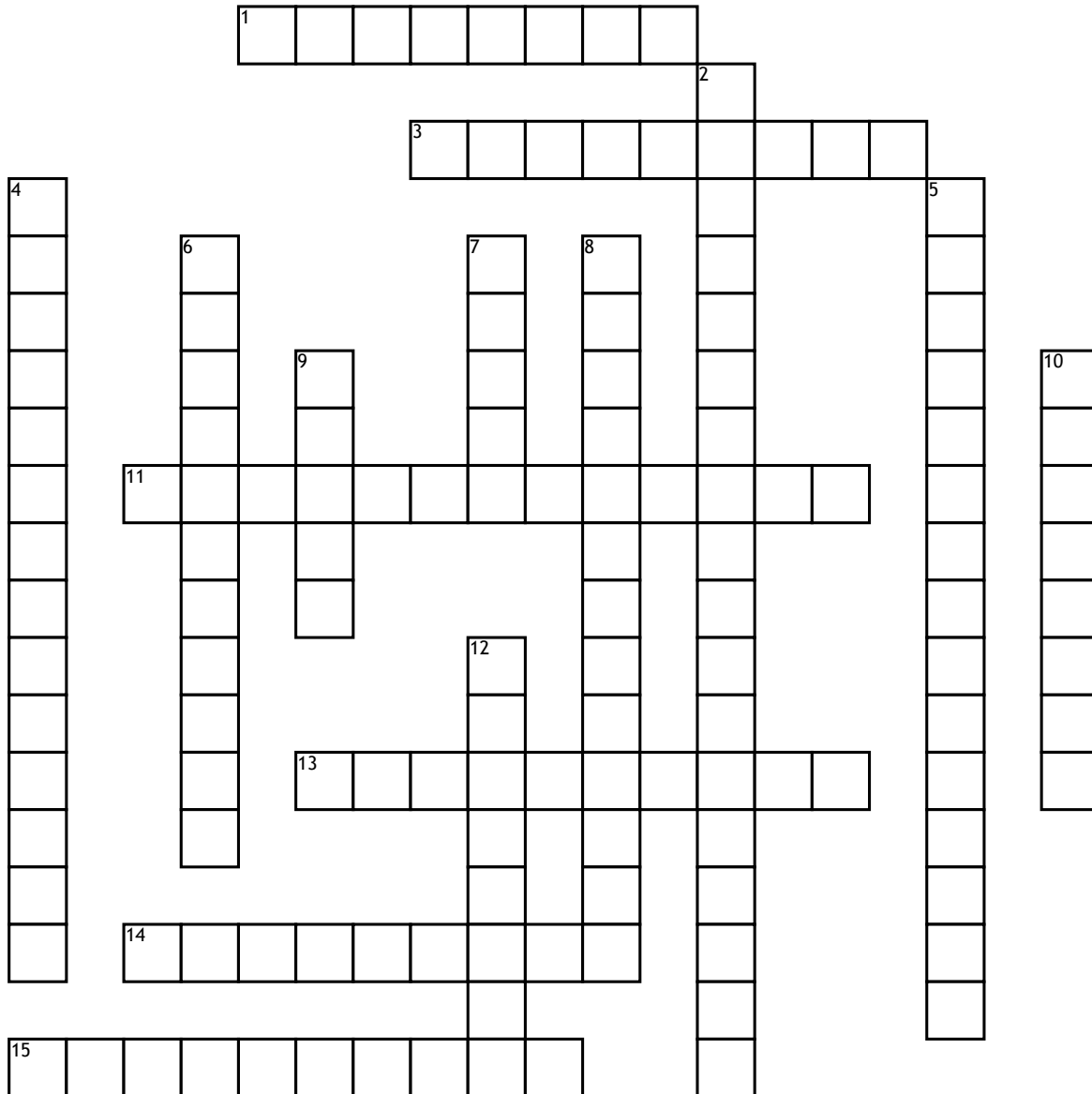


Enlightenment crossword
