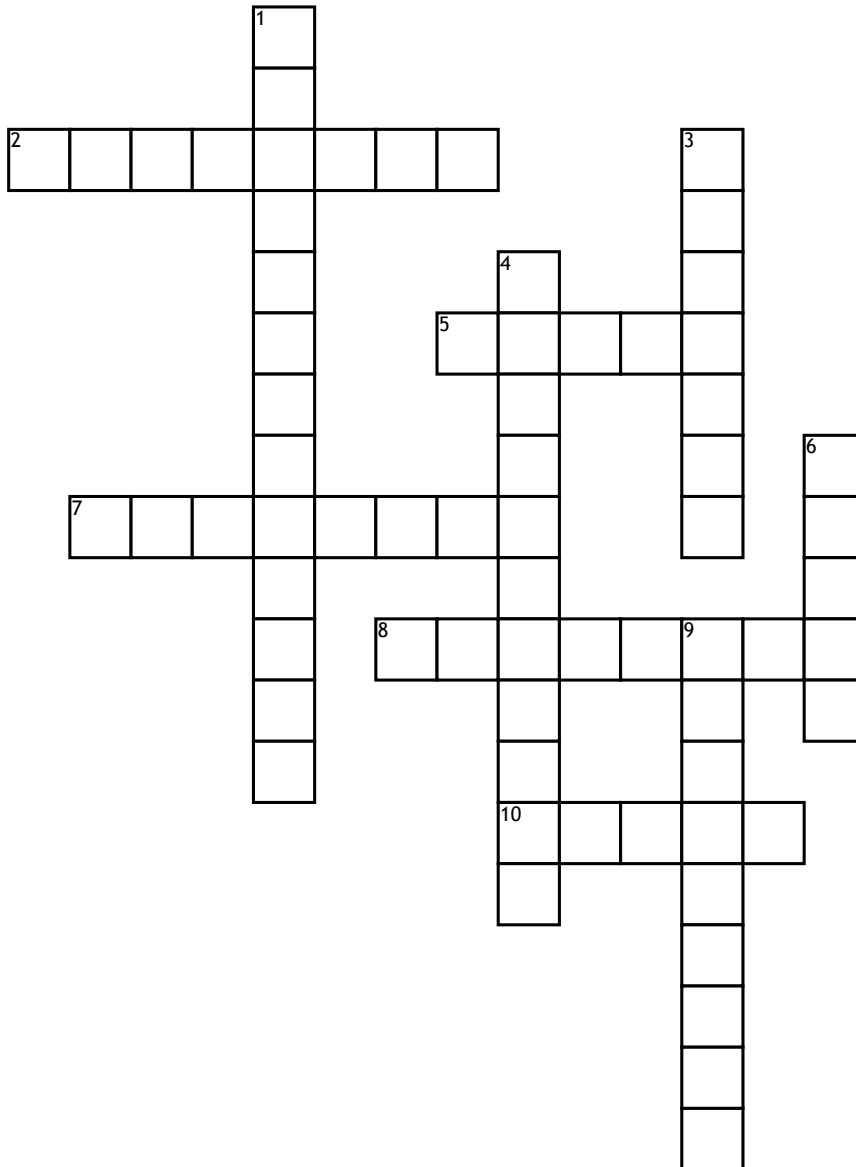

# Enneagram 1



## Across

2. 1/3 of the Freudian theory that drives One's morality (used to demand self-control and morality)
5. shame (felt when failing to live up to their own standards)
7. a person who publicly supports or recommends a particular cause or policy (a personal sense of mission to overcome adversity - even with personal sacrifice)
8. The name of this Enneagram type
10. a characteristic of this instinctive type (typically directed at the self for failing to live up to their ideals)

## Down

1. another name for this Enneagram type
3. the power to influence or direct people's behaviour or the course of events (usually in reference to the self)
4. having or displaying an excessively critical point of view (used to separate themselves from others when seeing their own failings in them)
6. honesty (they search for acceptable rationale for what they feel they must do)
9. the quality of having strong moral principles (this is a "basic desire" for Ones)
