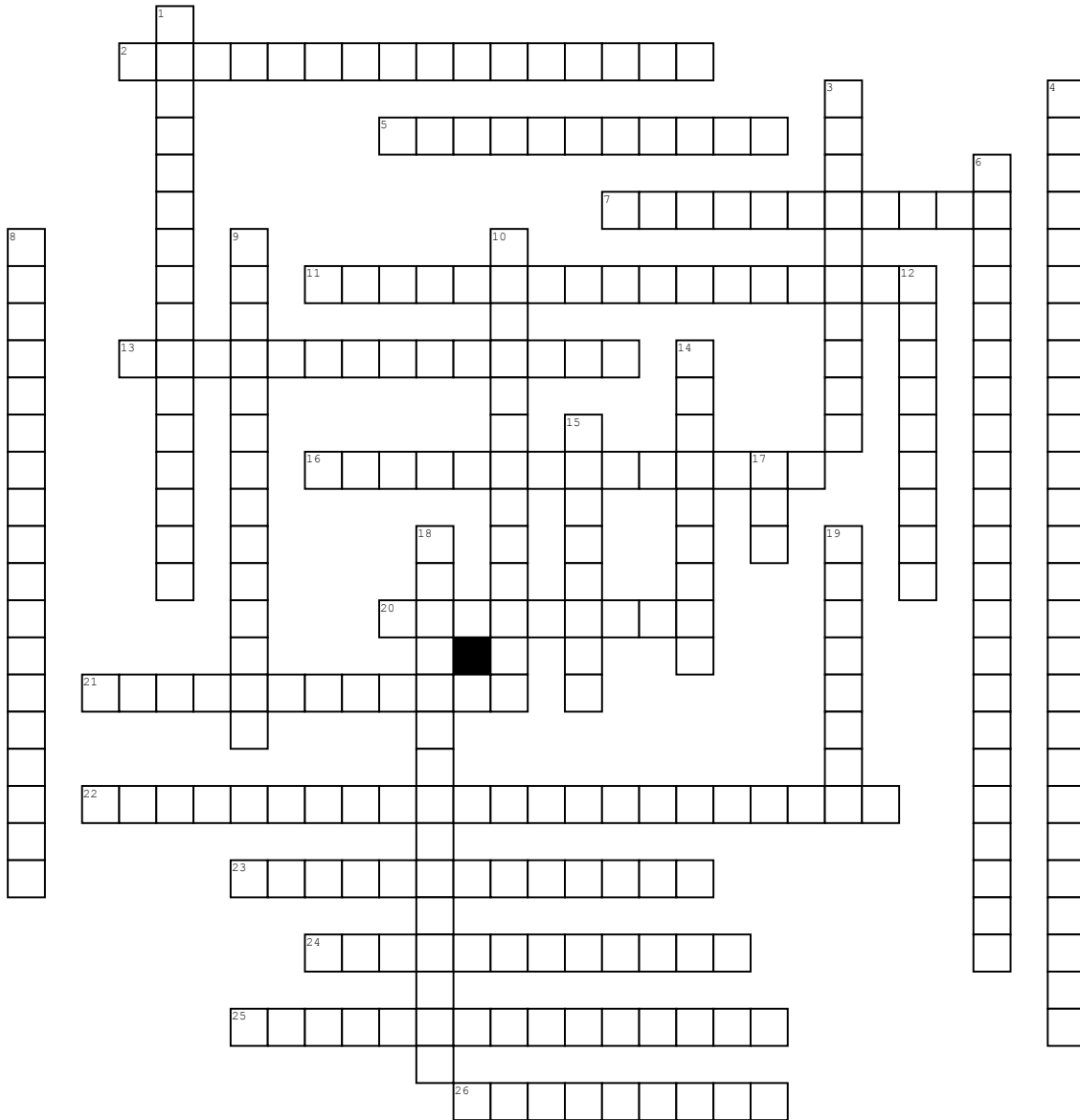


Entree#3- Crossword Puzzle
