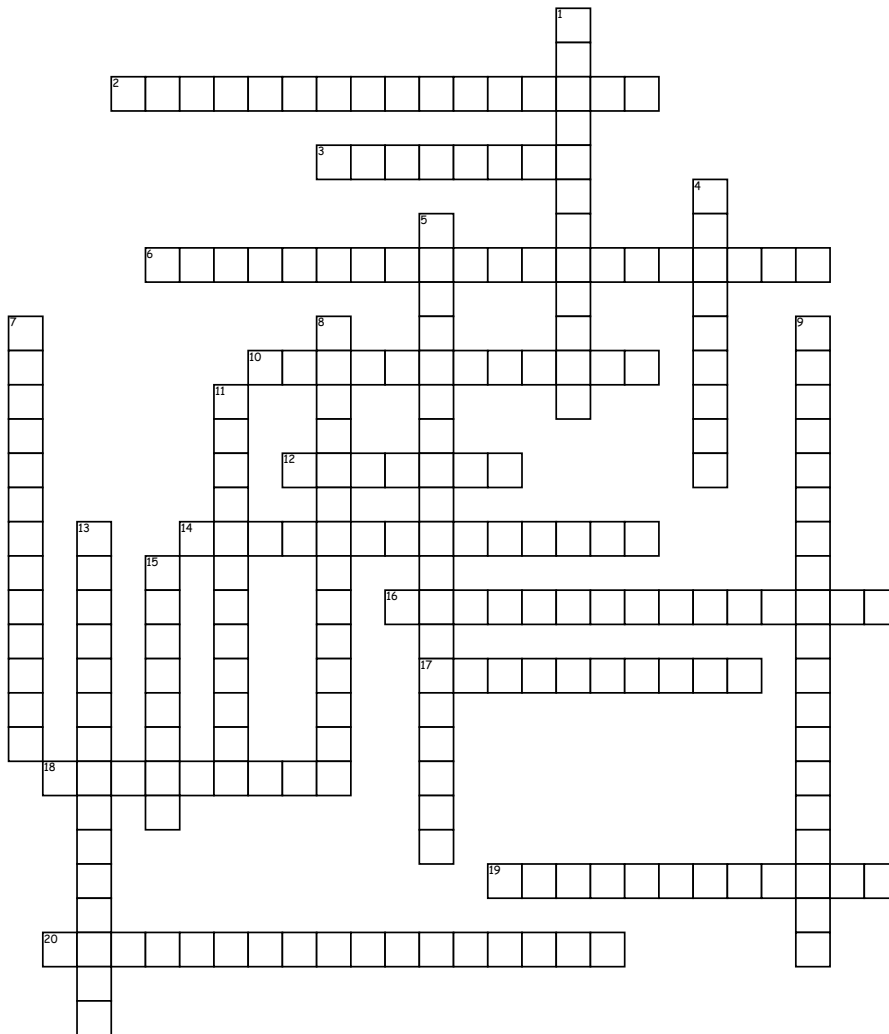


Era of Andrew Jackson
