1. Active Eruption
  2. Gingival recession makes tooth appear longer
  3. Movement of tooth through tissue so the crown appears longer
  4. Crowns form first, Root formed last. Should have all of these by the age of 3
  5. First tooth to erupt is Mandibular 1st molar
  6. Replace Primary Teeth
  7. Normal wearing away of occlusal surface from chewing
  8. When teeth do not develop
  9. 1st molars have an eruptive force pushing forward toward midline and erupt occlusally to meet antagonist in opposite arch
  10. When your teeth glide/grind together
  11. Not everyone has these teeth
  12. Which gender's teeth usually erupt first?
