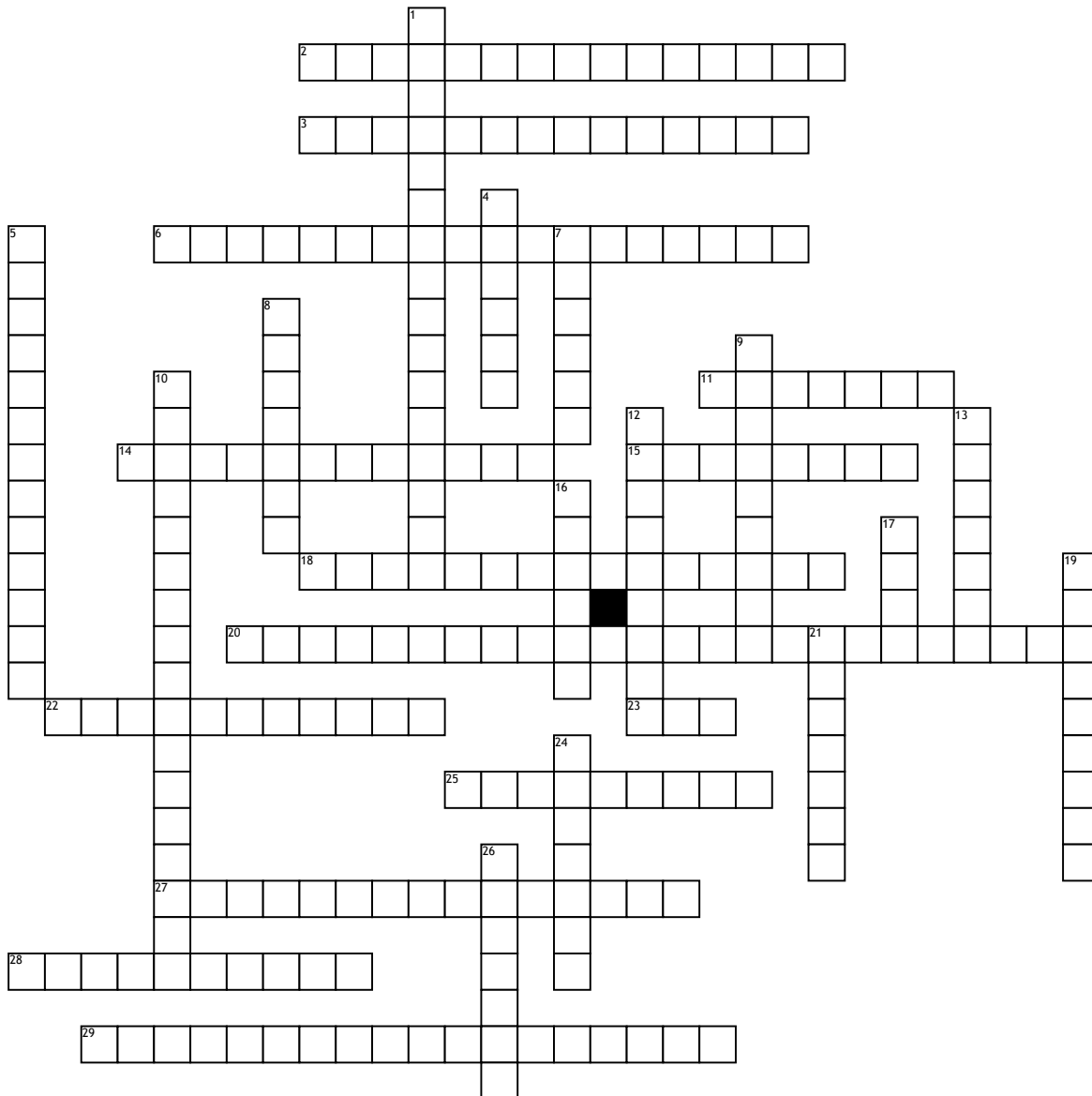

27. an election to choose a political party's candidate for an elective office

28. person who represents the United States government in foreign nations; the president appoints U.S. ambassadors

4. the official release of a person charged with a crime, at the request of a chief executive

9. /a slowdown in economic activity for at least two consecutive quarters (6 months)

12. a pact made by the president directly with the head of a foreign state; a binding international agreement with the force of law but which (unlike a treaty) does not require Senate consent EXECUTIVE

13. persons appointed by a president or governor to head the executive departments of government and act as official advisers to the executive

16. a formal agreement between two or more sovereign states

17. money owed to a person, company, or government

19. an individual who seeks an elected position in local, state, or national government

21. betrayal of one's country by levying war against the United States or offering comfort or aid to its enemies

24. member of a party chosen in each state to formally elect the President and the Vice-President

26. the amount by which a sum of money falls short of the required or expected amount
