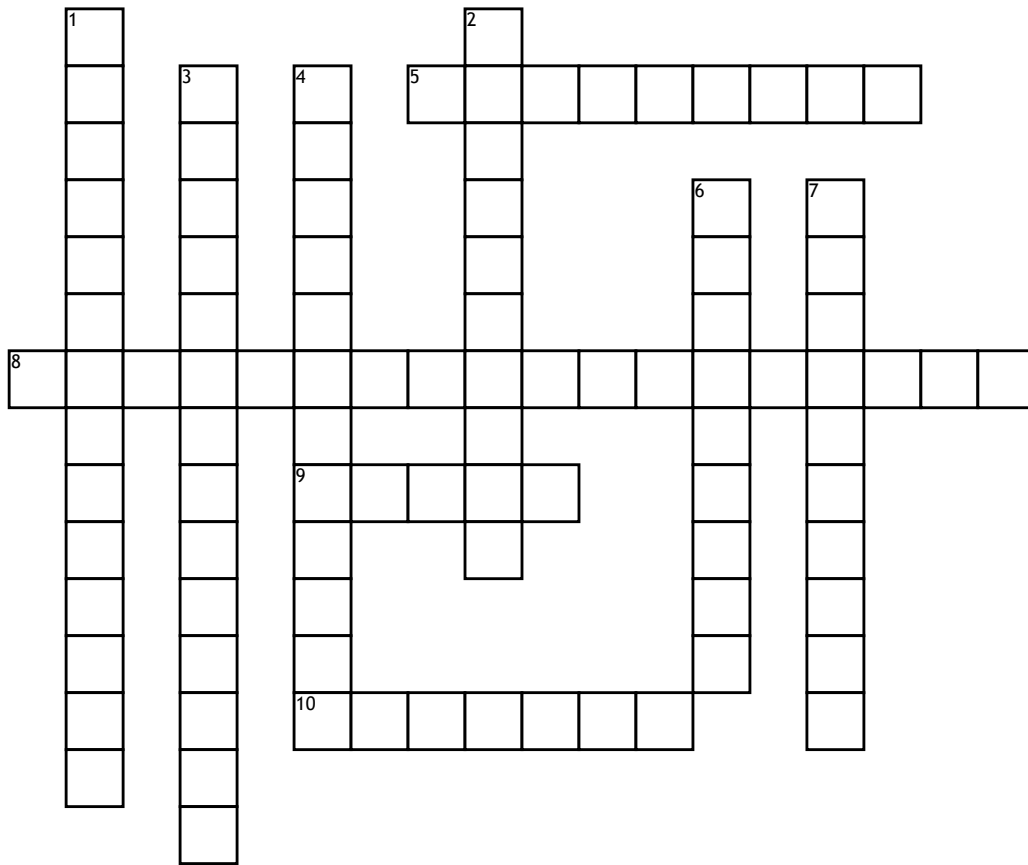


# Exploring Skeletal and Muscular System
