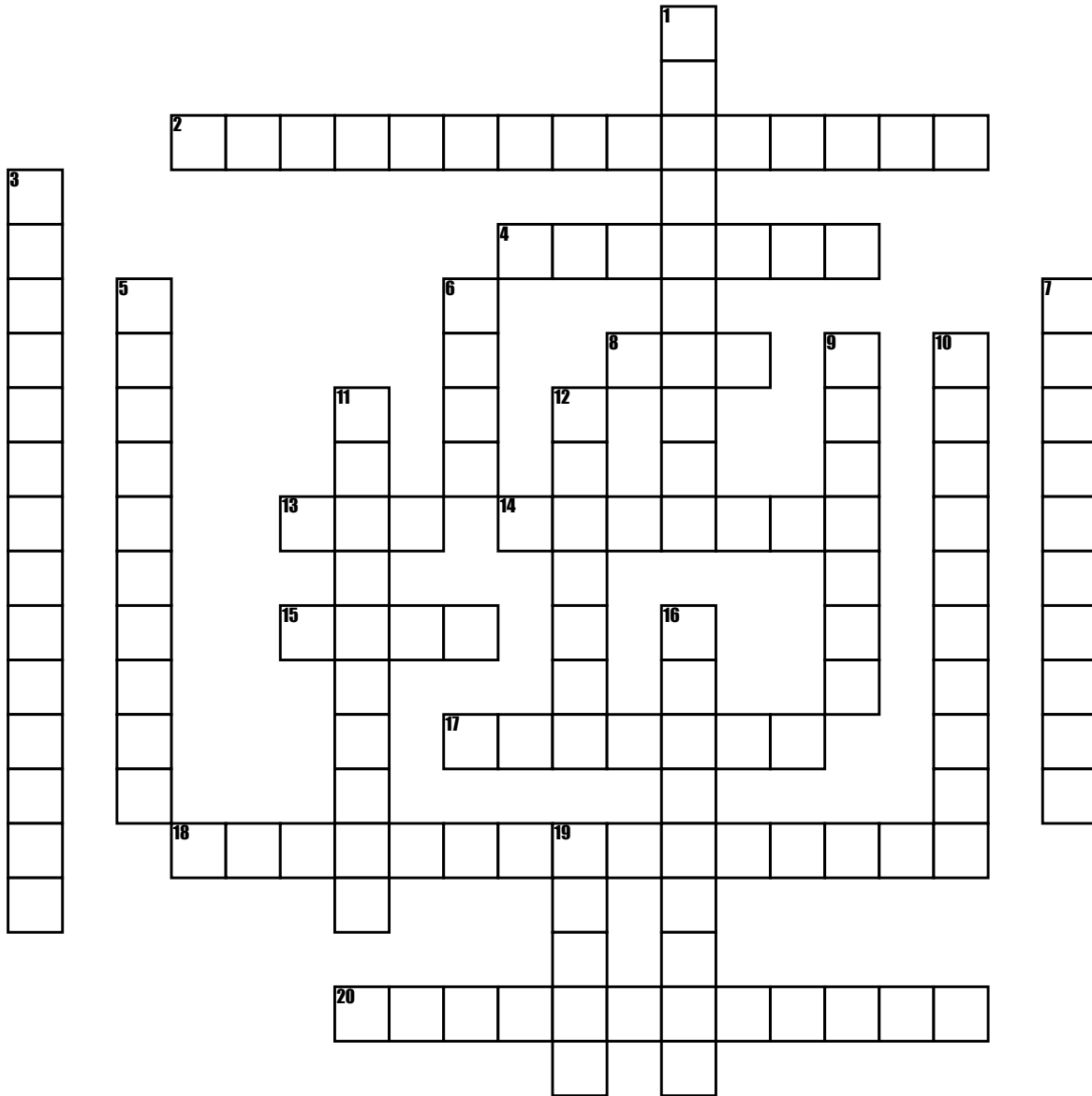


# Extremely Loud And Incredibly Close Crossword Puzzle
