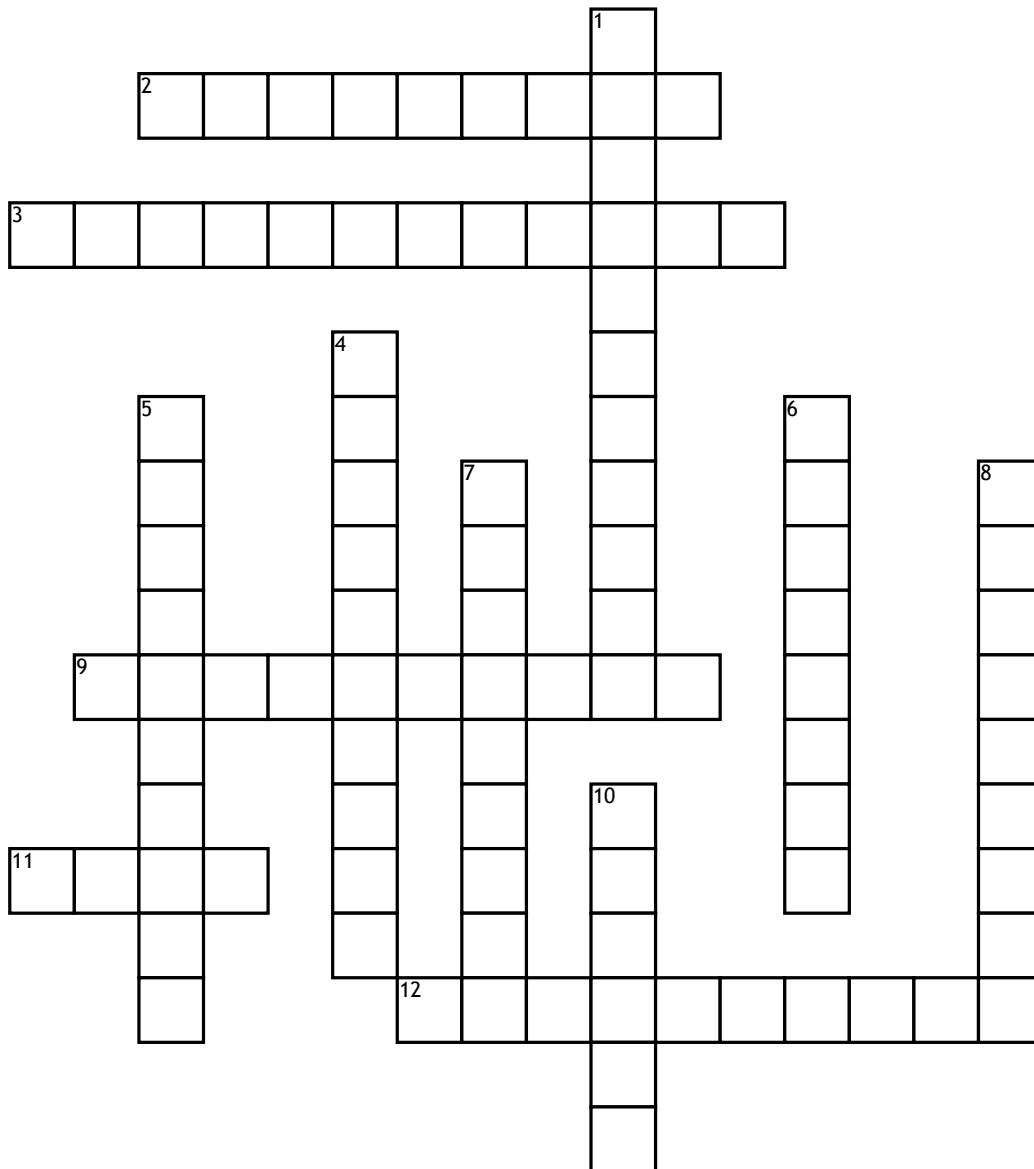


Fahrenheit 451 Cycle 1 vocabulary
