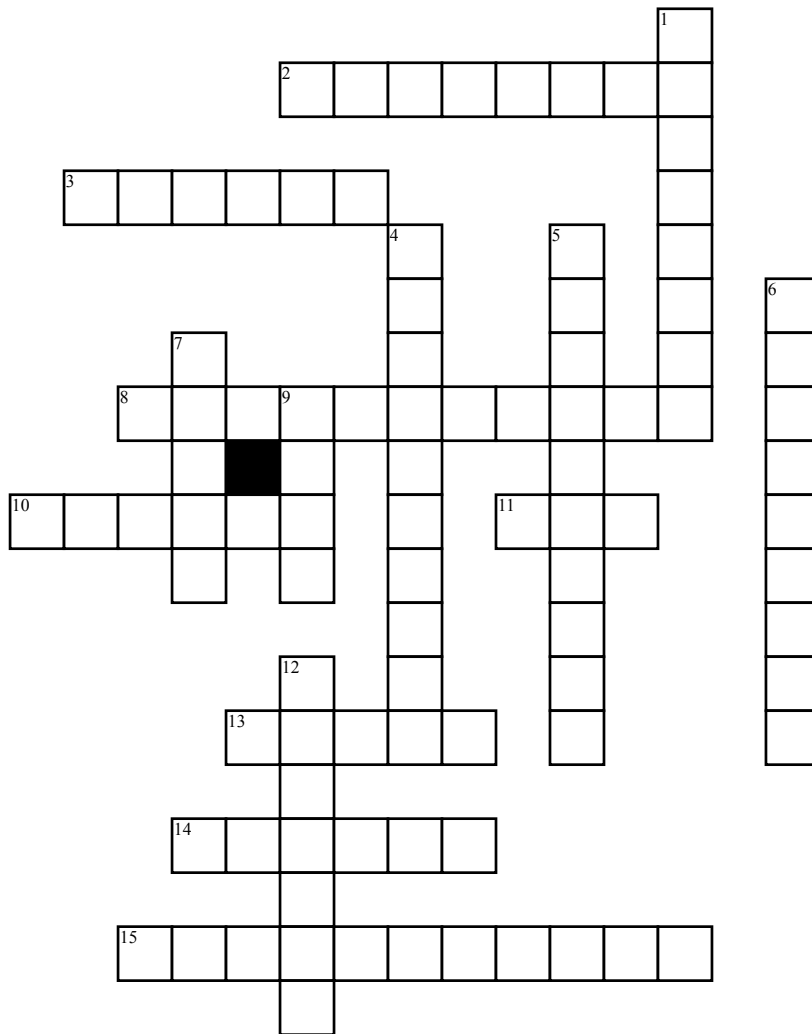


# Faith vs Medicine
