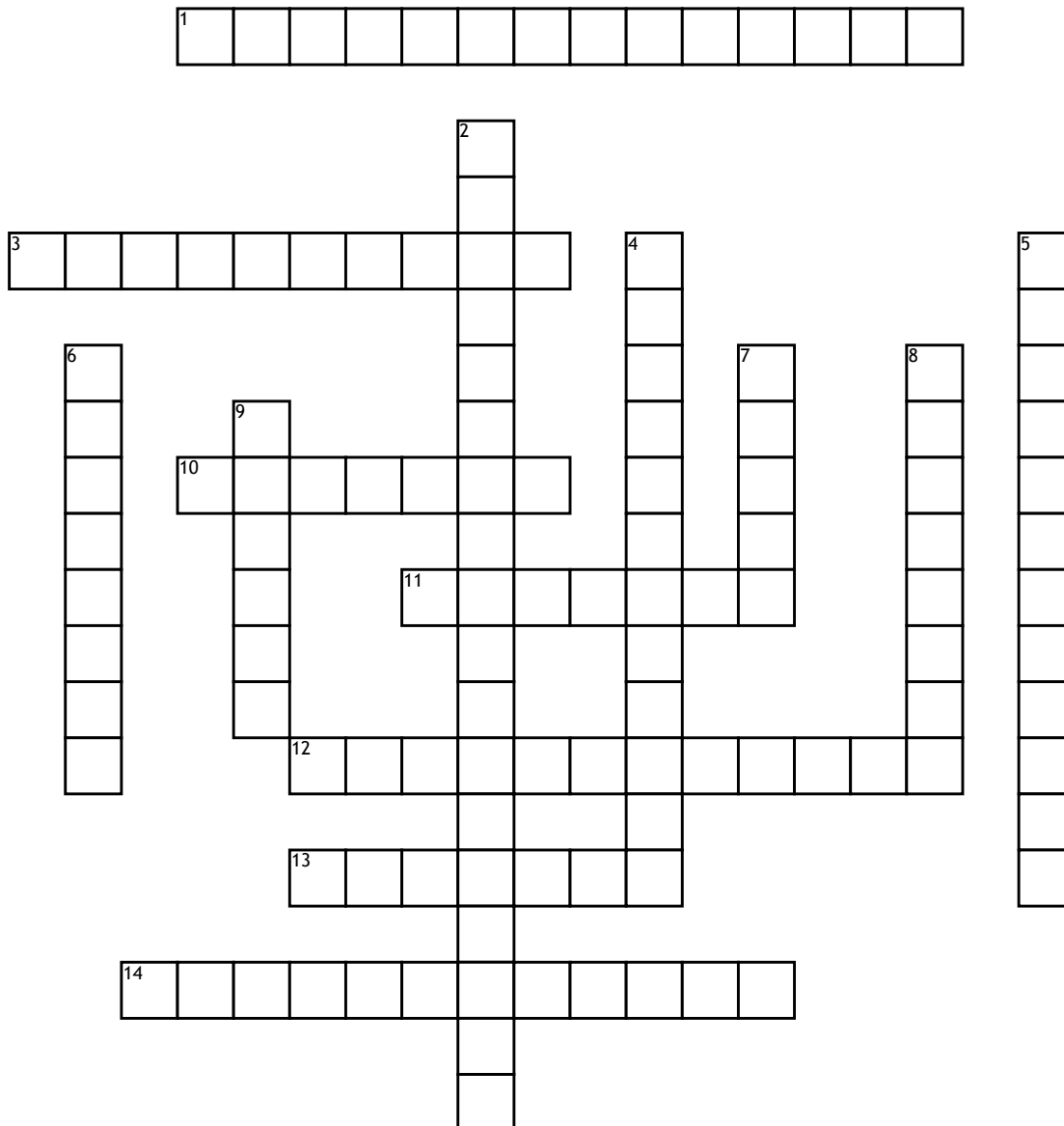


# Faiths in Canada (Crossword)
