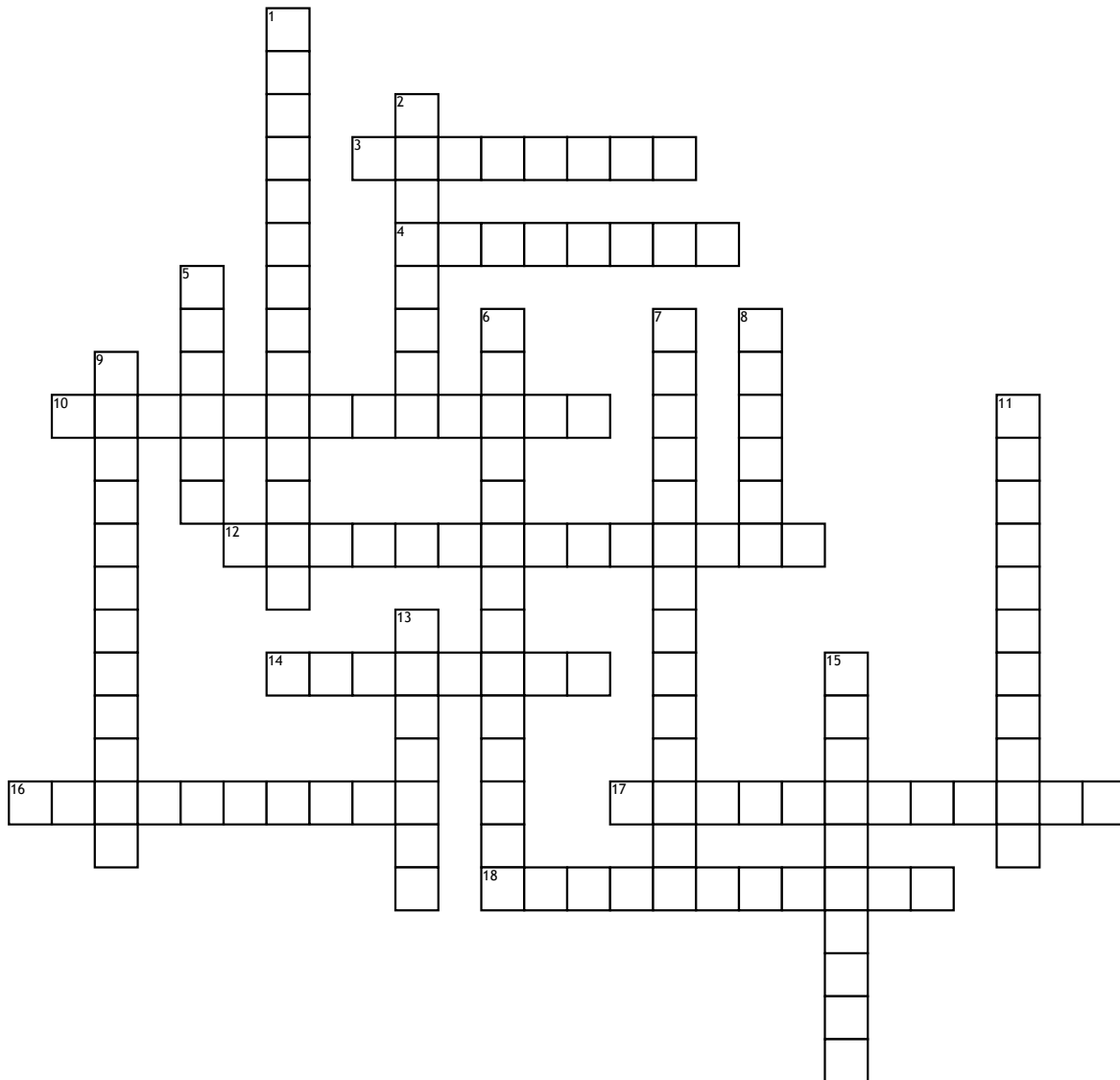


Fall Prevention Products & Strategies
