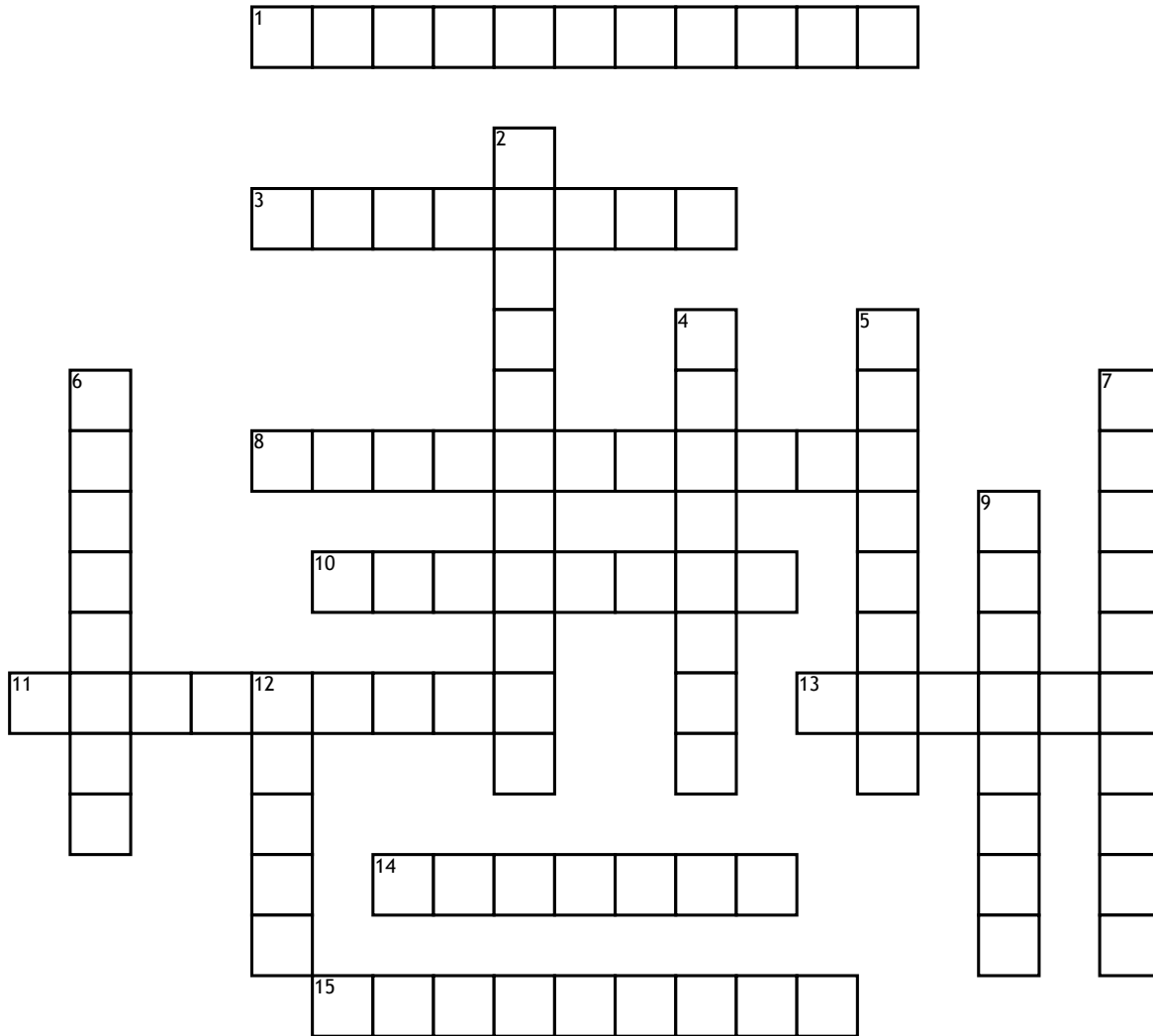


# Fallen Angles
