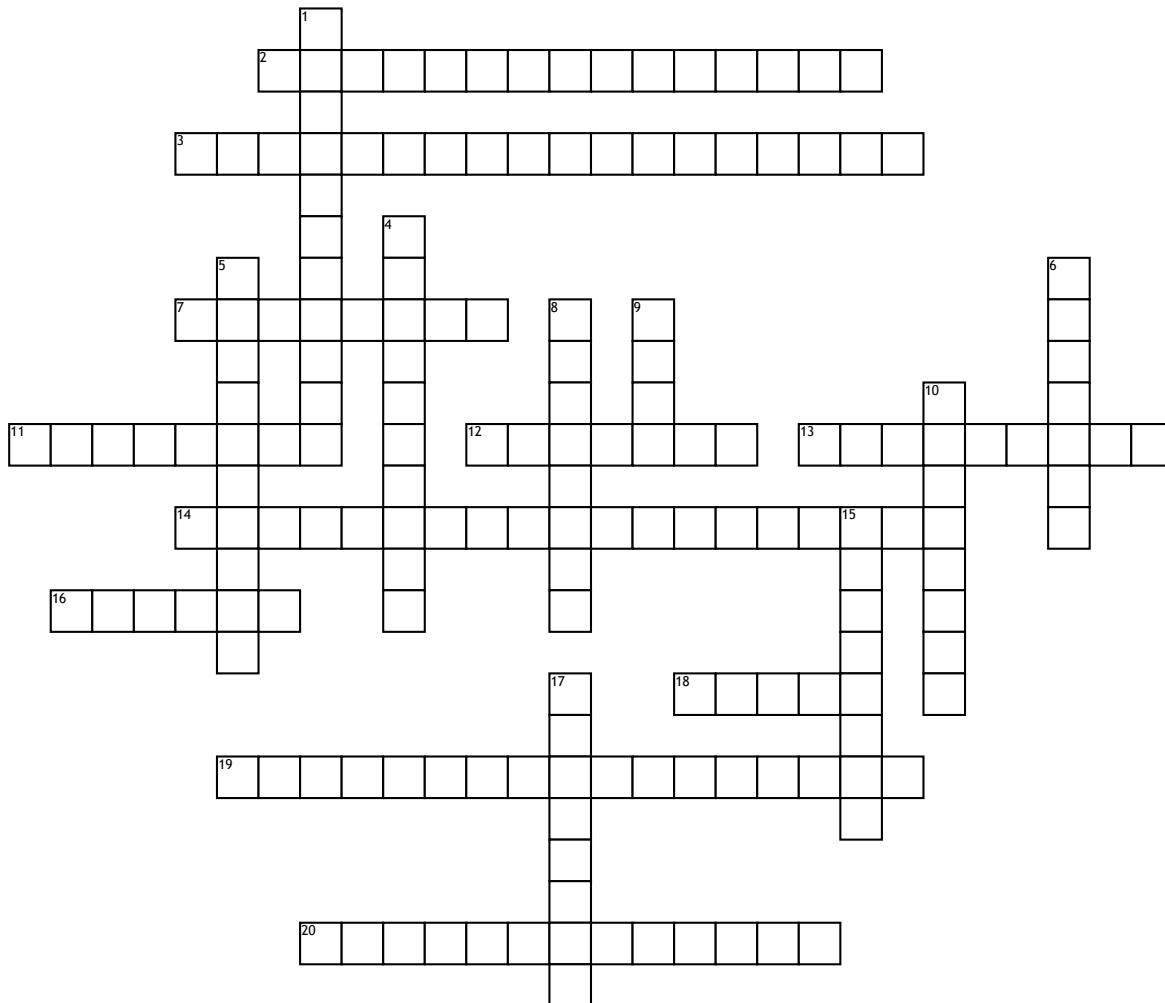


# False Claims

2. Recipient false claims & provider false claims  
 3. A hospital who obtain interim payments from Medicare throughout the year  
 7. A person who breaks the law  
 11. Enforce the FCA by filing a complaint, under seal, alleging fraud committed against the Government  
 12. A healthcare company that is funded by the Federal Government  
 13. A punishment imposed for breaking a law, rule or contract  
 14. Prohibits compensation in exchange for government funded healthcare services

16. Allows persons and entities with evidence of fraud against the federal government  
 18. Criminal deception intended to result in financial or personal gain  
 19. Pharmaceutical and medical device companies are prohibited from marketing these products that are not FDA approved  
 20. A person who informs on a person or organization engaged in an illicit activity
